1. Race you to the finish line! Flip all the way to the back of your Bible for this one: John, who wrote the last book of the Bible, Revelation, was exiled on an island called Patmos. In what body of water does the island of Patmos lie?
2. What is a place in Judah where Samson battled Philistines and killed 1,000 men with a jawbone of a donkey? (Judges 15:16-17)
3. As recounted in the Bible, what European countries did Paul travel to during his tenure as a missionary?
4. "When two full years had passed, Pharaoh had a dream: He was standing by the Nile, when out of the river there came up seven cows" (Genesis 41 v. 1-2) Pharaoh became increasingly troubled that no-one was able to interpret his dream. Who, eventually, unlocked its significance?
5. According to Exodus 3:1, on what mountain did Moses encounter a burning bush?
6. According to 1 Kings 18:19, what was the name of the mountain where Elijah had a showdown with four hundred and the fifty prophets of Baal?
7. Jesus had some friends who lived in the village, while He was present on earth. What were their names?
8. According to 2 Chronicles 3:1, on what mountain did Solomon build the temple of the LORD?
9. According to Genesis 8:4, where did Noah's ark land?
10. After parting the Red Sea for Moses and the Israelites, what body of water did God part for Joshua and the members of the twelve tribes some forty years later? (Numbers 32:14-17)

11. Jesus is recorded as being present at a feast in Bethany once. While there, He was questioned by some of his disciples, (notably Judas Iscariot) about a woman who was present wasting such an expensive ointment on Him, instead of selling it and donating the money to charity. How did Jesus respond? (This is according to the King James Version of Matthew 26:6-13.)

12. Acts 16: 24-38 tells of Paul and Silas being put in prison for preaching Christianity. In what community were they imprisoned? (Acts 16: 12)

13. In Luke 4:16 it tells of people in Jesus' home town attempting to kill him. What's the name of his hometown?

14. Matthew was a tax collector who was also known as Levi. The calling of Levi as a disciple is recorded in Mark 2: 13-17 with verse 1 reporting about the location of Jesus at the time. Where did the calling of Matthew take place?

15. Centuries later, Mary and Joseph clocked up some unexpected mileage when, at the height of Mary's pregnancy, they were required to travel to Bethlehem for a census. Approximately how far was their journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem?

16. Which river in the Bible was turned into blood by Moses, not only as a sign from God, but perhaps as an illustration of the great loss Egypt would suffer later on?

17. What modern nation(s) was/were known as "Babylon" during the time of Daniel and Ezekiel?

18. Acts 9: 25 tells of the apostle Paul escaping from a city by being let down in a basket through an opening in the town wall. What's the name of city?
