We proclaim that through faith in the finished work of Jesus we have access and citizenship to this kingdom. Not only that, but we are royal heirs of this kingdom with full rights to the benefits, protection, and resources of this kingdom through Jesus.

THE KINGDOM OF GOD SYSTEM

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: The Kingdom of God system works on the seedtime harvest principle. – Mark 4:26-30

I. The world has been more wise in working their system than we have been in working our system (Luke 16:1-8)

- A. The world has been more wise in doing wrong than the church has been in doing right
- B. We need to put the effort in to become educated and wise in our system
- C. When you’re talking about working the system you’re talking about, “How do I get from A to B?”

1. Matthew 6:33 – Tells us that when we are in need we are to seek the Kingdom of God.

a. What exactly are we to seek?

II. Our power lies in our understanding of the Kingdom of God system and in our willingness to work this system (Psalm 103:19)

A. The Kingdom of God system rules over all, but if we don't understand the Kingdom of God system and how to work this system, then we do not have access to the power of this system

B. As a believer, apart from doing things God's way and working God's system you have no power

1. EX-The power to be delivered from debt lies in the Kingdom of God system and apart from the Kingdom of God system you have no power to be delivered from debt.

C. If we want to walk in power and get results in our lives then we must understand the Kingdom of God system and be willing to work the Kingdom of God system

III. Jesus compares the Kingdom of God system to the natural farming system. The Kingdom of God system is like the system of natural farming. (Mark 4:26-30)

A. In the system of natural farming you have:

1. A farmer
2. The seed

3. The field
 4. The tree (vine, stalk)
 5. The harvest
- B. In the Kingdom of God system you have:
1. You- the farmer
 2. The word-seed
 3. The ground of your heart
 4. The tree of your belief/Kingdom
 5. The harvest of results in your life
- C. The word of God is the seed that travels down the pathways of the eyes and ears that lead to the heart. When that word seed is sown into the ground of your heart a **belief** is produced. When that belief is developed it yields the results you have in your life.

IV. The Kingdom of God system is like a man sowing seed into the ground (Mark 4:26-30)

- A. In the Kingdom of God system the seed is the Word (Mark 4:14, Luke 8:11)
1. When you're in need in the Kingdom of God system, the first thing you must do is go to the Word and get the seed
 - a. Without seed, you have **no potential** to see a harvest
 - 1) The harvest is in the seed
 - b. The Bible is not a book of rules it's a bag of **seed!**

2. To the farmer the seed is absolutely necessary and essential
 - a. In the Kingdom of God system you can do nothing without the Word-Seed.
 - 1) How far will a farmer get in the system of farming without getting the seed necessary to produce the harvest that he desires? How far will a believer get in life without the seed of God's word that is necessary to meet the need he has?
 3. When you're talking about God's way of doing things, when God wanted to create something physical (add something to Himself) he used words (Hebrews 11:3)
 - a. Words are what God used to create everything physical thing we see
 - b. Words became flesh and gave us the son of God
 4. One of the greatest stunts that devil has ever pulled on the Body of Christ is that he's gotten many Christians to believe that words are just words and they really don't make much of a difference. He's trying to work the deception that what you spend time saying and what you spend time listening to is not going to affect your life.
 - a. The words that you spend time saying and the words that you spend time listening to are **the key issue in life**
- B. In the Kingdom of God system, the soil or the ground is your heart (Mark 4:15)

1. The ground brings forth the harvest (Mark 4:28)
 - a. Your heart is going to take the word-seed that is planted in it and bring forth the harvest in your life (Proverbs 4:20)
 - 1) Whatever the Farmer puts in the ground in seed-form, manifests out of the ground in harvest-form.
 - 2) Whatever you put in your heart in word-form will come out in manifested-form.
2. In the Kingdom of God system your heart or your recreated spirit is designed to be the **production center** of your life. That whatever you send to it in seed form, it's going to produce it in manifested form in your life. (Matthew 12:33-35)
 - a. The word-seed in your heart, then your heart works with the seed to produce a belief, and then that belief yields fruit in your life – The Production Center Of Your Life.
 - b. Soil will only produce outside of it, whatever is inside of it and our hearts are the same way
 - 1) Whatever you want outside in manifested-form must be sown first in seed form
 - c. Can I rightfully expect to see something in my life that I have no sown in my heart?

V. How the Kingdom of God system works–The seed, the tree, the fruit –The

Word, The belief, The results (Matt 12:33-37)

- A. The seed of the Word is sown into your heart and it produces faith/a belief in your heart (Romans 10:17)
1. The tree comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God
 2. Faith (the tree) has to be developed before it yields fruit. Trees that aren't developed don't yield fruit (Mark 4:28)
 - a. First the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear
 - 1) The seed doesn't just come out of the ground in manifested fruit form
 - b. The first thing the word seed does is it produces a belief (That's the blade)
 - c. The second thing that happens is that belief begins to develop (That's the growth and development of the tree)
 - d. After that the belief will manifest the result in your life (That's the harvest or the fruit being brought forth)
 3. Words that you spend time with, will produce a belief in your heart
 - a. Hearing the wrong words will produce a wrong belief
- B. That belief in your heart begins to produce results in your life (Proverbs 23:7, Matthew 8:13)
1. The belief that the word-seed produces is like a tree in that it yields the fruit of your life (Luke 8:12)
 - a. The results that spring from your belief are like the fruit that springs

forth from a tree

2. The kind of fruit that you have is determined by what kind of tree that you have
 - a. The results you have in life are determined by the kind of belief you have in your heart.
 3. EX: If you spend time sowing the word on healing, it's going to produce a belief in your heart that you are healed. That belief is going to produce the fruit of healing manifested. You had to have the tree of belief to get the fruit of healing.
 4. Your life is a product of what you believe
 - a. You can't go any further in life than what you believe in your heart
 - 1) You can't produce any fruit beyond that tree
 - 2) You can't bear any results beyond what you believe
 - b. You are limited or empowered by what you believe
- C. Whatever words you're seeing, hearing, and saying are being sown in your heart. When those words are sown in your heart, they begin to develop faith in your heart. Then that tree of faith bears the results you see in life (Matthew 12:37)
1. Your belief is a product of the word seeds that you've sown in your heart
 - a. The kind of tree you have is determined by what seed you planted in the ground.

- 1) The kind of belief you have in your heart is determined by the kind of words that you've sown in your heart.
- b. Whatever word-seed that you put in your heart is going to determine what you believe and what you believe will determine the results that you get
 - 1) There's a tree inside of every believer that was produced by the word-seeds that they sowed in their hearts. That tree (belief) yields fruit and produces the results that a believer gets in their lives.
- c. 37-By your words you're justified (Rendering to each his due) or by your words you're condemned. By your words you're healed or sick, by your words you're prosperous or poor, and by your words you're victorious or defeated.
2. Your life is a **sum total** of **the words** that you've sown in your heart
 - a. Your life is a product of the words that you've sowed into your heart
 - 1) You can't become anything greater in life than the words that you spend time sowing in your heart
 - b. Battles are won and lost with the words that you spend time sowing

VI. In the Kingdom of God system there's word-seeds, there's the ground of your heart, there's the tree of your belief, and then there's the fruit-results in your life. (Numbers 13, Hebrews 3:19)

- A. The Word seed
 - 1. What did God say?
 - a. Exodus 33:1-3 – God said He would drive out the giants
 - b. Numbers 13:1 – God said He had given the land to the Children of Israel
 - 2. What did the enemy say?
 - a. Numbers 13:31-33
- B. The Ground of their heart – What had they sown in their heart?
 - 1. The ten spies sowed the evil report into their heart (Numbers 13:27-29, 32-14:1-4)
 - a. They gave their thoughts and attention to the evil report (the giants, the walls, the people)
 - 2. Joshua and Caleb sowed the word (Numbers 13:30-31, 14:7-9)
 - a. They gave their thoughts and attention to the Word
- C. The tree of their belief – What did they believe? (We can find out what they believe, by looking at what they said in the time of pressure)
 - 1. The ten spies believed they couldn't go in (Numbers 13:31)
 - a. Where did that belief come from? They spent time with the wrong words
 - 2. Joshua and Caleb believed they could go in (Numbers 13:30)
 - a. Where did that belief come from? They spent time with God's words
- D. The fruit results – What did they get?
 - 1. The ten spies and all the people that believed like them never went in;

they got the fruit of their belief (Num 14:28-34)

a. Hebrews 3:19 – Their unbelief shut them out; their tree kept them out

1) A result couldn't be produced in their life, that was different than what was in their heart

2. Joshua and Caleb went into the promise land; they got the fruit of their belief (Joshua 14:7-11)

E. All of this began because they spend time with the wrong word-seeds

1. The words that they looked at, listened to, and spoke determined what they got in life

THE WORD-SEED

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: In the Kingdom of God system the Word-Seed carries the power-potential to produce a harvest. – Luke 8:11

I. In the Kingdom of God system the Word is the Seed (Luke 8:11, Mark 4:14)

A. The Bible is not a book of rules it's *a bag of seed*

1. When you're in need in the Kingdom of God system, the first thing you must do is go to the Word and get the seed

2. We have been given all things that pertain unto life and godliness through these precious seed promises (2 Peter 1:3-4)

a. Anything that you would ever need that has to do with zoe or being like God has been given to you in the form of a seed

- 1) You have healing, financial prosperity, victory, and deliverance
in seed form
- b. God gave you the word-seed and that was grace
 - 1) Grace without faith will keep the word in seed form
- B. To the farmer the seed is absolutely necessary and essential if he desires
to see a harvest
 - 1. To the farmer who wants to harvest corn, can he do it without the
seed? No. To the believer who wants to harvest financial prosperity can
he do it with the Word seed? No.
 - 2. In the Kingdom of God system you can do nothing without the Word-
Seed.
 - a. The Word of God is precious seed-promises that are designed to
create faith and faith will yield the harvest.

**II. The power potential to produce a harvest lies in the seed (Romans
1:16, Hebrews 4:12)**

- A. There is an inherent or built-in ability in a seed to cause itself to come to
pass.
 - 1. Natural seed carries a power to bring itself to pass; The Word-Seed
has the built in ability to bring itself to pass
 - a. The Word-Seed of God carries the power of God (Romans 1:16,
Hebrews 4:12)
 - 1) The power to be healed is in that word-seed, the power to be

prosperous is in that word-seed, the power to be victorious is in that word seed

2) If a person doesn't take the seed of the Word to faith, then it can't become the salvation

b. No Word = No power

B. Without word-seed you have no power to produce a harvest

1. The power to produce a full harvest of corn lies in the corn seed

a. The power to see healing manifest is in the word-seed of healing

b. Without tomato seed you have no ability to see a harvest of tomatoes because the power to see a harvest of tomatoes is in the seed

2. No word (seed) = No faith (tree) > No faith (tree) = No fruit (results)

C. **The word is incorruptible seed. (1 Peter 1:23)**

1. The word-seed is seed that will not fail under any circumstances when it's planted in the ground of the heart

a. There is **no thing** that can keep this word from coming to pass

1) Outside things (problems, sickness, debt, poverty) don't stop the seed of God's word from working, because the seed of God's word cannot be corrupted

2) Jeremiah 17:7-8 – This tree is incorruptible; Things around it aren't effecting it's production

b. There is no situation where the Word is not enough

- 1) James 1 – It's the perfect law of liberty
 - 2) John 1, 1 Corinthians 13:8 – It's God and it never fails
 - 3) The Word will not fail to produce faith and faith will not fail to be the victory
2. Things that make it impossible for the seed of God's Word to work
 - a. 1) If it's not in the heart
 - b. 2) If you're not walking in love

III. We release the *power potential* of the Word-seed by sowing it into our hearts

- A. That power is released **only** when that seed is planted in the ground
 1. When that word-seed is planted in the heart there is a **power release** and that word-seed begins to work to bring itself to pass (First the belief, then the development of it, then the harvest)
 - a. There is healing power in seed-1 Peter 2:24, there is provision power in seed-2 Corinthians 9:8, and there is a release of that power when that word-seed is planted in the ground of your heart
 2. The power isn't released, and the word doesn't come to pass because you know it in your head; the power is released and the word comes to pass when it is sown in your heart
 - a. **EXAMPLE:** The power that the seed carries is not released when that seed is sitting in the back of the truck, the power of that seed is

released when that seed is planted in the **ground**. The seed starts becoming when it is sown.

- B. The seed has the potential to reach full harvest, but seed that is not planted, will be seed that does not reach it's full potential
 - 1. Seed that is sitting in the back of a truck is nothing more than seed with untapped potential
 - a. If a manifestation is what you desire, then I have to tap the potential of this word-seed by getting this word in my heart
 - b. The way to bring something forth from a place of unseen to a place of seen is to sow that thing in word-seed form in my heart and that thing will be brought forth in my life
 - 1) We are desiring to bring this thing out of seed from into full manifestation
 - 2. Untapped seed potential – Mark 4:35-41
 - a. The potential for them to get to the other side is wrapped up in the word seeds that Jesus spoke to them
 - 1) The biggest hurricane that this planet has ever seen can't corrupt that word seed and keep it from coming to pass
 - b. They prayed and asked Jesus to do something that he gave them power to do when he gave them the word seed
 - 1) If he's given me the seed for it, then I don't have to pray and ask him to do something that I have the potential to do through the

seed that He has provided

c. How is it that you have no faith?

1) How is it that you have no tree, when I've given you the seed?

C. When that word is in your heart it is working 24/7 to bring itself to pass

(Isaiah 55:11)

1. Mark 4:27 – The Farmer was sleeping and rising night and day with that seed in the ground and that seed was working all of the time to manifest itself

a. As long as that seed is in the ground, that seed is working 24 hours a day 7 days a week to bring itself to pass

b. I might not even be able to see that it's working, but I know that it's working because the seed is in the ground



WORDS BECOMING THINGS

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: Word-seed will become physical things when they

are sent to the ground of our hearts and developed into fully persuaded faith. –

Hebrews 11:3, John 1:14

I. Word-seeds will manifest themselves as physical things

A. When you're talking about God's way of doing things, when God wanted to create something physical he used words (Hebrews 11:3)

1. God spoke this planet into existence (Genesis 1)

a. Everything that you see on this planet was created by words

1) Every physical thing on this planet is a manifestation of Word-Seeds

b. We want to do things the way God does things and He used words

1) To create physical things God used words and if we are going to do things God's way then we have to use words

2. Every physical thing on this planet has its origin in words; every physical thing originated from word-seeds

a. The human body was formed out of the dust of the ground, but the dirt was created by words and in turn your physical body was created by words

1) You can trace every man and woman back to the first man and woman and they were created by words

b. All plant and animal life can be traced back and the first one was created by words

c. Any material things that man created can be traced back to the first material that the man used and that was created by words

3. We live in a word-created and word dominated universe
- B. Words become physical things
1. Words becoming...
 - a. John 1:14 – The Word became physical flesh
 - 1) God’s way of getting a redeemer into the Earth was through words
 - a) Genesis 3:15, Isaiah 53, 9:6, Jeremiah 23:5,
 - 2) Luke 1:30-38
 - a) The Holy Ghost impregnated Mary with the seed of the Word
 - b) She had to get impregnated with the seed of the Word in her heart, before she could get impregnated with the seed of the Holy Ghost in her womb
 - b. Proverbs 4:22 – Words became physical healing to flesh
 - 1) Psalm 107:20 – Words became healing and deliverance
 - c. John 8:32 – Words become physical freedom
 - d. Mark 4:35-40 – Words becoming physical peace
 - 1) Peace was words first. Be still was words first. Words became.
 - e. Mark 11:12 – Word became a cursed tree
 - f. 1 Samuel 17:34-37, 45:48 – Words became victory
 - 1) David had to have heard what he spoke from God before he spoke it and then he sowed the seed

- g. Daniel 3:16-18 – Words became deliverance
 - 1) They had to have heard those words before they spoke those words and then they sowed the seed
- 2. This apple started off as this little seed. When it was planted it produced a tree and then off of that tree came this apple that began as one small seed.
 - a. This seed has the potential to be this physical thing
 - b. EX-This wife, this ring started off as these word-seeds. When these word-seeds were planted into the ground of my heart, they produced a tree-belief, and off of that belief became this physical wife and this physical ring. Words became a physical engagement ring and a wife and dwelt among me.
- C. We live by the words that God has spoken to us (Matthew 4:4)
 - 1. We make our living by this Word
 - a. The just live by faith (tree), but faith comes from this word
 - 2. This word is our source and our supply
- D. **APPLICATION:** Words have the potential to become physical things. Whatever physical thing you need in life, you have to start with the Word that it's going to become from.
 - 1. To create physical things God used words and if we are going to do things God's way then we have to use words when we need to create things in our lives

II. The seed of the Word becomes by first of all producing faith in your heart

- A. The seed of the word becomes faith (Mark 4:27-28)
 - 1. The seed springs and grows up
 - a. We see the word seed growing and developing and becoming
 - 2. Words that you spend time with become faith in your heart (Romans 10:17 – Faith becomes by sowing the seed of the Word)
 - a. The tree is a product of the seed. Your faith-tree is a product of word-seeds.
 - b. Can you expect to have a belief in you if you never spend time with word seeds to create and develop that belief?
- B. The process of the word seed becoming --- Word seed becomes faith – Faith yields the result in your life – That fruit became from word-seed
 - 1. The way natural seed has to become a plant first the word-seed has to become faith first.
 - a. There's a step of between the seed and the fruit
 - 2. Words become faith first. They don't just become the fruit. (Mark 4:28)
 - a. First the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear
 - 1) There's progression or development here of the seed into faith and faith yielding the harvest
 - 3. What just started off as words, when they were sown, they developed a belief in your heart and has a man believes in his heart so is he.

- a. The Word of God is precious seed-promises that are designed to create faith in your heart and faith will yield the harvest.
 - b. The manifestation of what you desire starts off as a word-seed. When that word seed is sent to the ground of your heart it manifests into a belief in your heart (tree). That belief (tree) that started off as word seed will then produce results (bear fruit) in your life. That fruit that you see started off as a word-seed.
- C. Faith like a tree had to develop There's a process or development of believing
- 1. The first thing the word seed does is it produces a belief (That's the blade)
 - 2. The second thing that happens is that belief begins to develop (That's the development of the tree)
 - 3. After that the belief will manifest the result in your life (That's the harvest or the fruit being brought forth)
 - a. When you take an apple seed and plant it into the ground the purpose for that seed is to produce more apples. However the first thing that the apple seed does is that it works with the ground to grow and develop an apple tree. You will get no apples without an apple tree. The seed begins to develop and a tree begins to be sprung forth. The tree doesn't start producing apples the moment that it springs from the ground. That tree has to develop and grow before it

can yield the fruit of apples. When it has developed and grown, then it's gone through the process necessary to qualify itself to bear fruit. If there's no fruit yet, then the tree is not done developing. (Mark 4:28)

4. If the fruit is not there you're still in the process of believing.
- D. You develop your faith by watering the seed of the word with the water of the word and by giving light to the seed of the Word with the light of the Word. (Ephesians 5:26, Psalm 119:105)
1. You send the water of the word and the light of the word down the necessary pathways to reach the seed of the word
 - a. We are constantly sending the Word to the ground of our heart whether it be in seed-form, water-form, or light-form
 - b. If the fruit is not there, then your faith isn't developed and you should be sowing the Word to develop it.
 - 1) If you're not putting the word in to develop your faith, then you aren't getting any closer to your harvest.
 - c. We've said we've believed and that's okay because faith begins with a decision, but it's developed through time spent in the Word.
 - 1) You can't separate the development of faith (tree) from the time you spend in the word.
 - a) You believe huh? Well how much time have you spend in the word on it?
 2. Many people never get the harvest because they don't spend time

developing that tree

- a. What has made us think that we can get a harvest without developing our tree with the Word?

E. You have to develop your faith to the place of full persuasion where you believe you have received. Fully developed faith is fully persuaded faith.

1. Mark 11:23-24

- a. You have to believe you have it before you have it or harvest it

2. Romans 4:18-21

- a. 17-He's sowing the word seed by calling those things that be not as though they were

- 1) He's putting it in his eyes by looking at the sand and the stars

- b. 19-He didn't have weak faith (tree) because he didn't consider evil report

- 1) He didn't sow the wrong word seeds by listening to, looking at, and talking about what his body was saying or what her womb was saying

- c. 21-You have to have strong tree and fully persuaded tree to yield fruit

- d. 18-This is how we know he was fully persuaded

F. APPLICATION: In the process of a word-seed becoming it has to become faith first before it becomes fruit.

1. Too many times we get the word-seed and it doesn't become faith, it's

just head knowledge.

- a. Believers have missed it many times because they think they have faith in their heart, but all they really have is knowledge in their head and you can tell that by just watching what they say and what they do under pressure.
2. If a harvest is what you desire, then the seed of the Word has to become faith in your heart first and that faith has to develop.



THE GROUND OF THE HEART

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: Your heart is the production center of your

life. Whatever you send to it in the form of a word-seed, it will produce in your

life. – Matthew 12:33-35

I. In the Kingdom of God system the soil/ground is your heart. Your

heart is designed to be the production center of your life. That whatever you send to it in seed-form, it's going to produce it in manifested form in your life. (Matthew 12:33-35)

- A. The Earth will bring forth fruit of herself and your spirit will do the same thing-Mk 4:28
 - 1. The Earth will bring forth what's put in it
 - 2. Your spirit is going to bring forth what you put in it; good bad or indifferent; whatever word-seed you put in your spirit, your spirit is going to produce in your

- B. God has given you a production center called heart that will produce anything in your life that you plant in it in seed form (Proverbs 4:20)
 - 1. The word-seed in your heart, then your heart works with the seed to produce a belief, & then that belief yields fruit in ur life-The Production Center Of Your Life.
 - a. Whatever the Farmer puts in the ground in seed-form, manifests out of the ground in harvest-form.
 - b. Whatever u put in ur heart in word-form will come out in manifested-form.
 - 2. Mark 4:22-24
 - a. Every word-seed that you hide in your heart, will be manifested in your life
 - b. Be aware of what your hearing because what you hear will go into

your heart and manifest in life

- c. With what measure you mete, in hearing, it will be measured in harvesting

- 3. Proverbs 23:7 – Whatever is going on in my heart is going on in my life

C. The man who's sowing the seed is the man who's bring forth the harvest
(Mt 12:35)

- 1. The man brings forth based on what **HE** put in

- a. The man is determining what comes out based on what he puts in

- 2. God's given all these great things to you seed-form and now it's our job with the help of the Holy Spirit to bring them forth

- a. We do that be sending the word-seed to the production center of our heart and it will be brought forth in our lives

- 3. When something needs to be produced I send it down the pathway to the production center in seed-form

D. Can I rightfully expect to see something in my life that I have not sown in my heart?

- 1. Your spirit cannot bring forth something that has not been planted in there

- a. Soil will only produce outside of it, whatever is inside of it and our hearts are the same way

- 1) Whatever you want outside in manifested-form must be sown first in seed form

2. Matthew 12:35 – There had to be a good deposit before there could be a good thing brought forth

a. If u don't send good in, in seed-form, then good can't be sent out in harvest form

E. **APPLICATION:** Your heart is the production center of your life. That can be a good thing or bad thing based on what you put in your heart.

1. What you want to see in your life send to your heart in the form of a word-seed.

II. Guard your heart (Proverbs 4:23)

A. The Earth doesn't know the difference between a good seed and a weed seed; it's just brings forth fruit of herself (Mark 4:28, Matthew 12:35)

1. Evil things can be brought forth from the heart if evil things get deposited in

2. **EXAMPLE:** A fence post that's been in the ground for a while is rotted because the Earth is trying to bring forth that fence post. The first thing that the ground does to the seed is removes the shell. When something is planted in the ground, the ground is going to work to bring that thing forth.

- B. Guard your heart/Guard the production center – The word-seeds that dominate your heart will be the harvest that dominates your life
1. Above all keeping keep your heart
 - a. Obviously this is a serious thing to God if He's saying above all guarding, don't guard anything more than you guard your heart
 - 1) Why? That's where your life comes from
 - b. Keep your heart above all keeping – There's a urgency and seriousness in that
 2. Words are traveling down your eye-way and ear-way and getting into your heart and producing a belief and your life is coming from what you believe
 - a. Your life is coming from the deposits of word-seeds that you make in your heart
 - b. You'll become the words that you spend the most time with
 - c. If you believe that you'll guard your heart
- C. You guard the Heart/Production center by closing down the pathways to wrong seeds
1. The only way into the heart is through the eye-way, ear-way, and mouth-way. If you close down those pathways to bad word-seeds they won't get into your heart.
 2. You have to have authorization from God to go down these pathways that lead to my heart

- a. If you aren't the Word of God then you aren't authorized and you can't travel down that pathway
 - 1) What unauthorized word-seed-vehicles have you been allowing to travel down the pathways that lead to your production center?
- b. I'm closing the ear-way, the eye-way, the mouth-way, and the mind-way down to **authorized word-seed vehicles only**
- 3. If you want to stop something from being in your life, then you must stop it first on the word level
 - a. What you don't put in your eyes, ears, and say out your mouth won't reach your heart and won't be produced in your life

D. 4 Keys To A Guarded Heart (Proverbs 4:20-24)

- 1. 1) Attend to God's Word – You got to start putting the right thing in
 - a. Don't dwell on the problem, the circumstances or the evil report
 - 1) I see that, but I'm giving my attention to this
 - b. 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 – Cast down every thought that's not in line with God's word
 - 1) When you take thoughts that don't line up with God's word, those thoughts are non-verbal word-seeds that are being sown into your heart
 - c. Philippians 4:8 – Fix your mind on the Word
- 2. 2) Hear God's Word – Guard what you're listening to (Proverbs 4:20)

- a. Mark 4:24 – Take heed to what you hear
 - 1) Watch what you hear verbally and non-verbally
 - b. It's important to audibly hear yourself say the word, sometimes to shut up the voice of your mind
3. 3) Keep your eyes on God's Word – Guard what you're looking at (Proverbs 4:21)
- a. Proverbs 4:25 AMP – Open up the Bible and fix your eyes on the Word
 - b. Peter missed it because he put his eyes on something else (Matthew 14:24)
 - c. Abraham put his eyes on the stars & the sand and not on their bodies-Rom 4:19
4. 4) Speak the Word only – Guard your mouth
- a. Prov 4:24-Put away talk that's contrary to the Word-seed that you want to harvest
 - b. Joshua 1:8 – Fix your mouth on this word
 - c. We call things that be not as though they are to sow the seed that may be not. When you say what is you're just establishing and developing your belief in what is (Romans 4:17)
 - 1) When you talk the problem you are developing your belief in the problem

E. **APPLICATION:** Do not allow word-seeds to continually travel down the paths of your eyes and ears that you do not want to see come to pass in

your life. Guard your heart with all that you have because who's ever words are dominating the production center is determining what's being produced.



THE TREE OF YOUR BELIEF

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: What you have in life is coming from the tree of your belief in your heart. In the Kingdom of God system the tree that yields the fruit is your belief. The belief in your heart produces what you have in life. Your life is a product of what you believe in your heart. (Matthew 8:13, Proverbs 23:7)

I. The results in your life spring from your belief and like the fruit that springs forth from a tree

A. The results you have in life are determined by the kind of belief you have in your heart.

1. The kind of fruit that you have is determined by what kind of tree that you have

B. EX: If you spend time sowing the word on healing, it's going to produce a belief in your heart that you are healed. That belief is going to produce the fruit of healing manifested. You had to have the tree of belief to get the fruit of healing.

C. It's a possibility that you have some beliefs in you right now that are producing things that you don't want in your life

II. Your life is a reproduction of what you believe in your heart (Proverbs 23:7)

A. Whatever belief has been PRODUCED in your heart will be REPRODUCED in your life

1. Thinks – Reason out, calculate, reckon (consider), estimate,

2. When something is REPRODUCED that means that it's already been produced somewhere at sometime first and now it's going to be produced again

B. Whatever you want produced in life, first of all has to be produced in your

heart (in the form of a belief)

1. If I can produce the belief in my heart I can see the fruit in my life

III. Examples of “Your life is a reproduction of what you believe in your heart”

A. Hebrews 3:19, Numbers 13 – What you believe must make a difference because two of them believed and ended up going into the promise land and two million of them didn’t believe and they didn’t go in

1. Their tree was a tree of “we can’t do go in” and they got the fruit of their tree
2. They produced “we can’t go in” in their hearts and that was reproduced in their lives

B. Matthew 8:13 – Centurion’s Servant – It was done unto him, just like he believed it

1. His tree was “Speak the Word only and he’ll be healed” and he got the fruit of his tree
2. He produced “Speak the Word only and he’ll be healed” in his heart and that was reproduced in his life

C. Matthew 9:18,23-25 – Jairus

1. His tree was “If you lay your hand on her she will live”
2. He produced “Lay your hand on her and she will live” in his heart and that was reproduced in his life

D. Matthew 9:22 – Woman with the issue of blood

1. Her tree was “If I touch the hem of his garment I’ll be made whole” and she got *the fruit of her tree*
 2. She produced “If I touch the hem of his garment I’ll be made whole” in her heart and it was reproduced in her life
- E. Matthew 15:28 – The Syrophenician woman’s daughter – Just like she willed it and believed it in her heart it was done unto her
1. Her tree was “Jesus can and will cast the devil out of my daughter” and she got the fruit of her tree
 2. She produced “Jesus can and will cast the devil out of my daughter” in her heart and it was reproduced in her life
 3. Even As – It’s even or the same on both sides; as it is in your heart it’s even or the same in your life
- F. Matthew 17:20 – If they would have believed in their hearts could this situation have been different?
1. Their tree must have been “we can’t help this boy” because that was the fruit and the tree is known by the fruit and the belief is known by the results (Matthew 12:33)
 2. Their life was a reproduction of what they believed in their heart
- G. Matthew 13:58, Mark 6:4-6 – People who believed saw mighty works, they didn’t believe and they didn’t see mighty works
1. What they believed in their heart determined what they got in life
- H. Mark 9:20-23 – Is what he believes in his heart going to affect his life?

1. Jesus is saying, If you can get the tree, you can have the fruit or if it's not produced in your heart it can't be reproduced in your life
 2. If you don't have the tree, then it's impossible to see the fruit, but if you can produce the tree it's possible for you to see the fruit
- I. Mark 10:46-52, Matthew 9:29 – Blind Bartimaeus received sight – Did his faith have something to do with him seeing?
1. His tree was “Jesus can heal me” and he got the fruit of what he believed
 2. His life was a reproduction of what he believed in his heart
- J. Luke 7:50 – The Woman who as a sinner; her faith saved her
1. Did this woman's faith have something to do with her being forgiven from her sin?
 2. Her tree must have been “Jesus can and will save me” because that was the fruit she got

IV. APPLICATION: What you believe in your heart is what you have in life.

- A. If you want change in life, then you need to change what you believe in your heart
1. You got to believe that whatever your belief is, is exactly what you will have in life
- B. Whatever you want produced in your life, first of all has to produced in your heart



THE POWER OF THE FAITH TREE

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: As a believer your life has no choice but to line up with what you believe in your heart. – Proverbs 23:7

I. Spiritual law says whatever I believe in my heart I am in life (Proverbs 23:7)

A. As a man believes in his heart so is he

1. Proverbs 23:7, Proverbs 4:23, Matthew 12:35, Matthew 15:11,15-19, 3 John 2

B. If the Bible is true, and it is, then it's telling me if I change what I believe in my heart, my life has no choice but to transform into what I believe

1. Spiritual law says u can't believe one thing in your heart & have another

in your life

2. Because this is spiritual law this is going to work every time, all the time, no matter what the circumstances are
 - a. If you change what you believe in your heart, then your life is going to change and line up with what you believe every time, no matter what
- C. People have got unbalanced and in self-deception where this principle is concerned
 1. EX: They've said I believe I'm a millionaire and when it didn't happen they say see that didn't work
 - a. Just saying that you believe something does not prove that you believe
 2. Real belief/faith is faith that has been developed, faith that has been tried, and faith that has been proven. It's that kind of belief/faith that will come to pass in your life
 3. Questioning your belief?
 - a. What word did God speak that is the basis for my belief
 - 1) Apart from God saying something to you, you have no basis for faith
 - 2) EX: You can say that you have faith in me to pay your bills, but if I didn't say I was going to pay your bills, then you have no basis to believe that

- 3) EX: I believe in my heart that I am rich because God said I was
 - b. Faith has to be fully persuaded (James 1:6-8)
 - 1) You can't be double-minded and expect to receive a harvest
 - 2) You can't cross-pollinate your tree of faith with a tree of unbelief and expect to see a harvest
 - c. How much time have you spent with that word to develop your faith
 - 1) Apart from time spent with that word there is no development of your faith to the place of full persuasion
 - d. When your faith was tried did you pass the test?
 - 1) When pressure was put on your faith did it hold up under the pressure
 - 4. Faith is perceiving as real fact what is not yet revealed to the senses (Heb 11:1 AMP)
 - a. When you believe like this in your heart, this will come to pass in your life
- D. **APPLICATION:** You are what you believe you are, you have what you believe you have, and you're doing what you believe you can do. If you'll believe different, then your life has no choice but to be different.

II. The power of the faith tree is that it gives your life no choice, but to

line up with what it's saying

A. The three Hebrews (Daniel 3:28)

1. Their faith tree (belief) was “Our God who we serve is able to deliver us and He will deliver us”
 - a. They’ve set it up so that their life has no choice, but to get in line with this
2. Their belief is working and it won’t allow their life to be different than what they believe
 - a. They can’t die, they believe this
 - b. “I know you’re saying we’re supposed to die, but my faith tree is saying God will deliver me”
 - c. They were supposed to die in the fire, but they had a faith tree (belief) in them and their lives had no choice, but to line up with what they believed
3. The fire killed the men that threw them in the furnace because they got too close to the fire. But they went in the fire and the fire didn’t effect them
 - a. The fire effected the world, but it didn’t effect the people that worked the Kingdom of God system
 - b. It’s possible to get s faith tree in you and be in the middle of destruction, but unaffected by the destruction

B. Daniel in the lions den (Daniel 6:23)

1. 10-He must have believed God will deliver me
 - a. That's his faith tree
 2. 23-His belief was working and it wouldn't allow his life to be different than what he believes
 - a. He can't die, he believes this
 - b. Daniel was supposed to die in that lions den, but he had a faith tree in him and his life had no choice, but to line up with what he believed even if that meant getting thrown into a den of lions, and them not eating him
 3. 24-Those men represented the world and the lions that had no effect on Daniel greatly effected these guys
 - a. Daniel is working a system
 4. Daniel being delivered wasn't in God's hands. God already spoke His peace where Daniel's deliverance was concerned. If your enemy comes against you one way, I'll cause him to flee seven ways. Daniel's deliverance was in his hands. Will you believe?
- C. Abraham (Romans 4:16-21)
1. His tree was, "I am the Father of many nations."
 2. Their belief was working and it wouldn't allow their life to be different than what they believed
 3. They weren't supposed to be able to have a baby, but they had a tree of faith in them, and their lives had no choice, but line up with what they

believed. Even if that meant a 100 year-old man and a ninety year old woman with a dead womb having a baby.

D. **APPLICATION:** Your belief won't allow your life to be different than what you believe

1. Whatever has to happen has to happen, I believe this

III. There's no thing in this world order that faith cannot overcome (1 John 5:4)

A. It doesn't matter how impossible the situation may seem, if you'll get a fully persuaded tree of faith in you, your life has to change from what it is, to what you believe

1. My belief is working and it won't allow my life to be different than what I believe

a. We can overcome anything, by getting a fully persuaded tree of faith in us

2. Our means of success is our faith (tree)

a. With no fully-persuaded faith tree how victorious and successful can a person be?

B. The power of this faith tree is that it will override natural law.

1. Natural laws tell you that you cannot do and cannot be certain things under certain conditions

- a. Natural law says in a fire you burn, natural law says in a lions den you get eaten, natural law says a 100 year old man and a 90 year old woman don't have babies, natural laws say a baby born with half a heart dies
- 2. The law of faith can override natural law and take you to a place where you're not effected by the natural law
 - a. **EXAMPLE:** The Law Of Gravity vs. The Law Of Lift – When somebody releases the law of lift gravity is still working, but the law of lift has overpowered the law of gravity and kept that person unaffected by gravity. That airplane is not affected by gravity, because laws have been applied that overrode gravity.
- 3. Just like the law of gravity has no say when the law of lift is motion natural law has no say when the law of faith is in motion
- C. If you can believe no body and no thing can keep you from the manifestation
 - 1. 2 million people couldn't keep Joshua and Caleb from it, being 80 years old couldn't keep Joshua and Caleb from it, being 17 years old could keep David from it, having 300 men against 135,000 could keep Gideon from it, Being thrown in a fire couldn't keep the 3 Hebrews from it, being thrown in a lions den couldn't keep Daniel from it, being 100 years old and having a wife with a dead womb couldn't keep Abraham from it
- D. **APPLICATION:** If you develop a fully persuaded tree of faith, there is no

man, situation, or circumstance that can keep you from being victorious and receiving what God has for you

1. There is no thing in this word order that faith cannot overcome, so if you're in an impossible situation today know this, if you can get a fully persuaded tree of faith in you nothing can stop you from being victorious

IV. Inside every believer, there is a belief that has been developed through the words-seeds that they spend the most time with. That belief is yielding the results that they see in life. (Proverbs 4:23, Matthew 12:33-37)

- A. As believers we have to take responsibility for our lives and acknowledge that the fruit we have come from what we believe in our hearts
 1. Fruit doesn't come from nowhere; if there is fruit, there was always a tree; if there's a tree there was always a seed
 - a. Whoever is responsible for the seed sown your heart is responsible for the harvest you see in life
 2. Life is not just coming from nowhere (Proverbs 26:2)
- B. Too many times believers play the victim mentality where they blame people, situations, and circumstance for why they don't have something or why they aren't walking in the fullness of the promises of God

1. We need to stop playing the victim, change what we believe, and be the victor
2. In the Kingdom of God system, the blame for our failures goes solely on us
3. The church has not wanted to accept responsibility for their life; People like to play the victim

C. **APPLICATION:** When there's something in your life that you don't like, don't play victim, own up, take responsibility, and change what you believe and change your life.



MAKING THE TREE GOOD

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: To see change in our lives we must play our part

by changing what we believe. – Matthew 12:33

I. Make the tree good. (Matthew 12:33).

A. There's a tree or belief on the inside of all of us that's producing fruit or the results in our lives

1. The fruit matches the tree, the results match the belief

a. You're not going to have an apple tree that produces oranges

2. If you want to change the fruit you're getting you have to get a new tree

a. If want to change the results in your life, you have to change what you believe

3. Make the tree good – Not make it happen

a. If you make the tree good, the fruit has no choice but to be good

b. God made the system like this, your circumstances have no choice, but to line up with your belief

B. We need to be focused on making the tree good

1. Jesus puts his focus on the tree, not the fruit; he puts his focus on the belief not the results

a. Jesus didn't say make the fruit good; He said make the tree good

1) Whatever you make the tree, the fruit will be

b. He's revealing to us to focus on the belief that's in our hearts

2. Don't be distracted away from the process of making the tree good, by what's not happening in the natural

- a. Don't be distracted away from the process by negative reports, bad circumstances, or things not changing; be consumed with the process; be consumed with making the tree good
 - b. Don't be results-minded, be process-minded. If you mind the process of making the tree good, the results will be there; If you do this the results will take care of themselves
 - c. What's it matter what the doctor is saying? If you make the tree good, the doctor's report will change and get in line with that tree?
3. We have to stop being so focused on what's not happening on the outside and start being focused on what should be happening inside.
- a. What should be happening on the inside is that my faith tree should be developing and growing daily. I should be watering that tree with the Word and giving light to that tree with the Word.
 - b. Let's not be focused on the fruit that we have, but don't want. Let's be focused on the tree because if we change the faith tree, the fruit will change.
4. Let's be so consumed and focused on growing and developing the right tree that we don't even pay attention to the outside circumstances in life
- a. Let's be possessed by the seed-promise and the process that it has to go through
 - b. Let's stop focusing on what's not changing on the outside and start focusing on what is changing on the inside fully-knowing that when your

faith-tree gets fully developed fruit and harvest will be the result

II. In the Kingdom of God system if we want change outside in life, then we must first of all start that process by changing what we believe in our mind/hearts (Matthew 23:25-26)

A. We've made the outside faith, but inside is unbelief

1. We know the right things to say and the right faces to make when we are around believers, but what's coming out when the pressure is of?

B. We have to acknowledge that in the Kingdom of God system the process of change works from the inside out

1. Any area where we are desiring to see change outside, we must first change our heart-belief inside
 - a. What the farmer has in the ground determines what he has out of the ground and if he wants to change what's coming out of the ground he needs to change what he's putting in the ground (Mark 4:26-30)

C. As believers we've been too flesh-minded in that too often we look to the outside at what's not changing and what's not happening and it distracts away from what should be happening inside

1. We got to fix our focus on making the tree good and changing the inside
 - a. I'm working the system and the system says if I make the tree good, the

fruit will be good

D. The process of change takes place from the inside out. The only way to see change in your life is by first of all changing what's in your heart. You don't **qualify** for change outside if you aren't **willing to engage the process** of changing what's inside.

III. **Your battle is not a physical battle (2 Corinthians 10:3)**

A. Our battle is not in the realm of the flesh

1. You don't have figure out how it's going to happen or do something to make it happen (Mark 4:26-28)
 - a. The farmer's battle was not to figure out how a harvest was going to come or to even make the harvest come. His battle was to take the seed out of the bag, put it in the ground, develop it, and if he did that he would see the harvest.
 - b. Our battle is not to figure out how the manifestation is going to come or to make the manifestation come. Our battle is to take the word-seed out of the bag, put it into the ground of our hearts, develop it into faith, and if we do that we'll see the harvest.
2. The she shall be made whole will be the result of you fearing not and believing only (Luke 8:49)

B. Our battle is in the realm of the spirit and it's to make the tree good

1. David's battle with Goliath wasn't about slingshots, rocks, and swords
 - a. David's battle was about the faith in his heart and he won the battle in his heart
2. You're not battling sickness and disease, you're not battling depression, you're not battling financial lack Jesus is Lord over sickness, disease, depression, and financial lack. He defeated those things and put them under your feet. (Ephesians 1:19)
 - a. Your battle is about what you believe in your heart.

C. Your fight is the fight of faith and that fight takes place in the heart (1 Timothy 6:12)

1. Fight the good fight of the faith tree
 - a. Fight – Used in both military and athletic endeavors to describe the concentration, discipline, and extreme effort needed to win
2. There's a conflict going on and there's somebody out there trying to stop you (Luke 8:12)
 - a. Satan's trying to stop you from making the tree good
 - 1) There's going to be opposition to you making the tree good
3. Your fight is to make the tree good/to make your belief good because if you make the tree good the fruit will be good
 - a. What choice does the fruit have, if the tree is an apple tree? No choice, the fruit has to be apples.

b. My battle is to develop that tree of belief in my heart



DEVELOPING YOUR FAITH TREE

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: The tree of faith has to develop to the place of full persuasion if it is ever going to produce results in your life. There's a process the Word-Seed must go through if it's going to manifest in our lives. – Hebrews 4:2

I. If we don't take this word-seed through the process of seed-becoming faith and faith-becoming fully developed, then we'll never see the seed of this Word manifest in our lives (Hebrews 4:2)

A. They had the word, but that word didn't become faith in their hearts and consequently that word didn't produce results in their lives

1. If the Word doesn't produce faith inside, then that word won't be reproduced outside
 - a. They didn't take the word-seed and develop a tree of faith consequently they never got the fruit
 - 1) Without a tree there is no fruit; Without faith there is no profit;
 2. This word has to become faith if you want to see the fruit, not head knowledge
 - a. It's possible for a born-again child of God with a lot of knowledge of this word in their head, to see no **profit** from this word in their lives if they don't take it through the **process** of word-seed becoming faith
 - b. A lot of believers have head-knowledge of the Word, but those same believers haven't taken the seed of God's word through the process necessary to develop faith in their hearts
- B. We have to understand that the seed of this word has to go through the necessary **process** to become fruit in our lives
1. This seed of the Word has to become a faith tree in our hearts
 - a. If this word-seed doesn't become a fully developed tree of faith, then we'll never see the fruit of the Word come to pass in our lives.
 2. This word-seed has to go through the **process of development**
 - a. When you take an apple seed and plant it into the ground the purpose for that seed is to produce more apples. However the first thing that the apple seed does is that it works with the ground to grow

and develop an apple tree. You will get no apples without an apple tree. The seed begins to develop and a tree begins to be sprung forth. The tree doesn't start producing apples the moment that it springs from the ground. That tree has to develop and grow before it can yield the fruit of apples. When it has developed and grown, then it's gone through the process necessary to qualify itself to bear fruit. If there's no fruit yet, then the tree is not done developing. (Mark 4:28)

- C. **APPLICATION:** If we aren't willing to take the Word through the **process** of becoming faith, then we will not see this word come to pass in our lives.
1. The word doesn't come to pass because you know it in your head. The word comes to pass because you sowed it in your heart and it became a fully-persuaded faith tree.
 2. Don't expect to something to be produced outside when you haven't taken the time to produce the belief for it inside.

II. The development of faith

- A. Faith can develop. There are levels of faith. (Mark 4:28)
1. Little faith vs. Great faith (Matthew 14:31, Matthew 8:10)
 2. Weak faith vs. Strong faith (Romans 4:16-21)
 3. The disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith (Luke 17:5)
 4. Faith comes by hearing in the word and if you're not hearing the word faith is not coming (Romans 10:17)

- B. Faith has to be developed before it produces results the way a tree has to be developed before it yields fruit (Mark 4:28)
1. First, then, after – That shows development and progression
 - a. First the blade; development, but no fruit yet
 - b. Then the ear; development, but no fruit yet
 - c. After that; fruit
 2. A little tree won't yield fruit, likewise little faith won't yield a harvest
 - a. Peter failed on little faith (Matthew 14:31)
 3. Too many believers are expecting to see a harvest with little faith
- C. **APPLICATION:** Faith that's not developed will not produce results in your life. Faith has to grow and develop before it's qualified to yield fruit.

III. If we expect to see a harvest we have to have a Fully Persuaded-Tree Of Faith

- A. Great faith of fully developed faith that is based solely on the word of God
1. Matthew 8:8 – Great faith is when the Word of God is final authority in your life
 - a. Matthew 15:28 – All she needed was the crumbs of the word
 2. Romans 3:3-4 – Great faith is developed to the place where God and His Word are true and anything that disagrees with his word is a liar
- B. Fully persuaded faith is faith that doesn't waver
1. Romans 4:16-21
 - a. Abraham didn't stagger, waver, or doubt and he was fully

persuaded

- b. He didn't start out like that; his faith developed to this place
 - 1) He was trying to have children with other people, his wife was laughing at God's promise
 - c. People who have weak faith will constantly be considering the circumstances, but people who have strong faith are so fully persuaded in what they believe that they pay no attention to the circumstances
2. We're supposed to be in faith without wavering (Hebrews 10:23)
- a. Wavering – Without bending, firm, unmoved
3. People who aren't fully persuaded in their faith will not receive the harvest (James 1:6-8)
- a. Nothing wavering – No wavering in your attitude or your confession
 - 1) Wavering – Doubt, lack of faith, to stagger, hesitating
 - b. Wherever the wind goes the waves go and when you're wavering wherever the circumstances go you go. If the circumstances are up, you're up and if they're down, you're down.
 - 1) A person who's fully persuaded in their faith is firm, fixed, and immovable in that the circumstances can go up and down, but they're same no matter what.
 - c. The person who doubts and wavers can expect to receive nothing from the Lord

C. Real Faith [Hebrews 11:1 (AMP)]

1. Faith is assured
2. Faith is the conviction of the reality of what you do not see
3. Faith is seeing something as real fact, that is not yet revealed to the senses
4. Faith isn't in the excitement of the moment; faith is in the day to day lifestyle of believing this Word; faith is believing that word 24 hours a day 7 days a week, no matter what you're doing, no matter where you're at, and no matter what's going on around
5. Faith is us finding you busy believing God and His Word

D. **APPLICATION:** As long as you're wavering, you will not see the word come to pass in your life. It is imperative as a believer that you get to the place where your faith is fully developed; because that's the only way you're going to see results in your life.

IV. You develop your faith by continuing in the Word

- A. You develop the seed of the Word into a fully persuaded tree of faith by watering the seed of the word with the water of the word and give light to the seed of the Word with the light of the Word.
1. You send the water of the word and the light of the word down the necessary pathways to reach the seed of the word (Ephesians 5:26, Psalm 119:105)
 - a. To develop fully persuaded faith you have to have the Word of God

constantly traveling down the pathways of your eyes and ears in the form of seed, water, and light.

b. Tree comes by watering and lighting and keeping the seed in the ground. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God (Romans 10:17)

1) Faith – persuasion or to be persuaded

2. What has made us think that we can get a harvest without developing our tree with the Word?

a. You can't separate the development of faith (tree) from the time you spend in the word.

3. If the fruit is not there you either didn't have the tree of belief to begin with or you're still in the process of believing.

a. If the fruit is not there, then your faith isn't developed and you should be sowing the Word to develop it.

b. If you're not putting the word in to develop your faith, then you aren't getting any closer to your harvest.

B. It's the act of continuing in the Word that will get you to the place of fully persuaded faith (John 8:31-32)

1. Truth – What is true in any matter under consideration, in reality, in fact, certainly

2. Know – To intercourse or become intimately acquainted with, indicates a relationship between the person "knowing" and the object known; in this respect,

what is "known" is of value or importance to the one who knows, and hence the establishment of the relationship, The same idea of appreciation as well as "knowledge" underlies several statements concerning the "knowledge" of God and His truth on the part of believers, such "knowledge" is obtained, not by mere intellectual activity, but by operation of the Holy Spirit

- a. I've had intercourse with this word, I've become intimately acquainted with this word, I have a relationship with this word, I've become one with this word, and it has become truth to me
3. What started off as word became truth through the act of continuing
- a. EX: I started off with just word that Jesus took poverty and gave me his prosperity, but through the act of continuing this word became truth and the truth is I am rich
4. What's the truth today?
- a. The word is truth (John 17:17)
 - b. One problem that believers have had is that they haven't stuck with this word long enough to have intercourse with the truth
5. When it becomes truth to you in your heart, then that truth will manifest in your life and make you free
- a. When it's truth to you in your heart it will become the truth in your life
- C. APPLICATION:** A part from the act of continuing in the word, your faith will not develop. A part from your faith developing you will see no harvest.

Therefore, the act of continuing in the Word is going to be one of **the major keys** in you seeing that word come to pass in your life.

THE UNBELIEF PROBLEM

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: God has provided everything that we would ever need that pertains to life and godliness, but if we operate with unbelief in our hearts, that unbelief will keep us from those things that are rightfully ours. – Hebrews 3:19 (AMP)

I. Unbelief (the wrong tree) will hinder a person in the Kingdom of God system.

- A. Unbelief shut the children of Israel out of the promise land (Numbers 13:25)
 - 1. In their minds they couldn't possess the land b/c (1) The people are strong (2) The cities are walled (3) The cities are great (4) All the land is occupied by strong people
 - 2. The real reason they couldn't possess the land was b/c of their unbelief-Heb 3:19
 - a. They thought the physical walls that man built kept them out of the promise land, but in reality it was the walls of unbelief that they built in their heart
 - 3. What's keeping the children of Israel out of the promise land?
- B. The disciples could not cure him because of their unbelief (Matthew

17:14-21)

1. The devil/the people didn't hinder them; their unbelief hindered them
2. They had a tree that didn't match the fruit they desired
3. What's keeping the disciples from healing this boy?

C. God has already provided everything for you that pertains to life and godliness, but if you have unbelief in your heart it will hinder you from having things that are rightfully yours

1. What's keeping you from being debt-free?
2. God had already given the land to them, but unbelief kept them from having what was rightfully theirs
 - a. EX: God has already provided all the money for you that you would ever need, but unbelief in the realm of financial prosperity can keep you from the financial prosperity that is rightfully yours.
3. If you don't have the belief in your heart, to match the results that you desire, then you will be hindered from seeing the results you desire.
 - a. EX: A person can desire to be prosperous, but without the belief to match what they desire, they'll be hindered from seeing what they desire

II. The problem in your life is not outside, it's in your heart

A. Their problem was not outside and it was not physical, their problem was in their hearts

1. They didn't have a wall problem, a strong people problem, or a cities

being occupied problem. God gave them the answer to that problem in Exodus 33:1; They had an unbelief problem.

2. You don't have a sickness problem, a lack problem, or a sin problem. Jesus defeated sickness, poverty, and sin and gave us the answers of healing, prosperity, and righteousness in his Word. Sickness isn't the problem, lack isn't the problem, and sin isn't the problem. The problem is unbelief.
 - a. If you can believe you're healed, then sickness has to leave your life. If you can believe you're rich, then poverty has to leave your life.
 - b. The devil isn't keeping you from being healed, prosperous, or delivered, it's unbelief; the tree is the problem
 3. We need not focus on the physical circumstances and situations because those things aren't the problem. Let's focus on **the real problem** and **the real problem** is unbelief in your heart.
- B. Every tree/believe that's not in line with the Word must be rooted out (Matt 15:10-20)
1. All of the unbelief that is in us, we have to root out
 - a. If you're still getting discouraged and down and making negative confessions and caving under the pressure, then there is a tree of unbelief that must be uprooted in your life
 - b. The belief that's in you is producing in your life, therefore if it doesn't line up with the Word, then it has to go

C. **APPLICATION:** The thing that is keeping believers from walking in the fullness of the promises of God and seeing victory in their lives is not impossible circumstances, it is not people, and it is not the devil. It is unbelief in their hearts.

1. Focus on the true problem; unbelief in your heart

III. In the Kingdom of God system the currency is faith. (Mark 9:23)

A. If you want to get anything done in the KOG system it's going to require faith/a tree

1. You can't bear any fruit beyond your tree and you can't bear any results beyond what you believe

- a. The way that a farmer has no chance of getting apples without an apple tree, you as a believer have no chance of getting the results that you desire without the faith that will produce it

- b. In the system of farming you can't bear any fruit without a tree, just like any the KOG system you can't bear any results without faith –

THE CURRENCY IS FAITH

2. In the Kingdom of God you can't do anything without faith

- a. The more faith you have the more you can do, the less faith you have the less you can do

3. For this man to see his son healed it's going to require faith

- a. The man tried to put the responsibility of his son being healed on Jesus, his compassion, and willingness to help, but Jesus put the

responsibility of that boy being healed on the man and his faith

- 1) The boy was not going to stay sick because Jesus lacked compassion or lacked a willingness to help
 - a) Psalm 46:1 – He is a very present help in the time of trouble
 - b) Psalm 86:15, 111:4, 112:4, 145:8 – He is full of compassion

b. Jesus is saying, “Not if I can do, but if you can believe.”

- 1) This man’s faith or lack there of was the only thing that was going to keep that boy from being healed
- 2) The results in your life are not determined by God (Matthew 12:35)
 - a) God’s “already done”, If you can believe

B. You can’t go any further in life than what you believe in your heart

1. The boundary or limit for what you can do in life is what you believe in your heart (Proverbs 4:23)
 - a. You can’t go any further than your tree. You can’t produce fruit beyond that tree. You can’t have results beyond your belief.
 - 1) Num 13-The children of Israel couldn’t go in b/c they didn’t believe in the heart
 - 2) 1 Samuel 17 – The men of Israel couldn’t defeat Goliath because they didn’t believe and David could because he believed

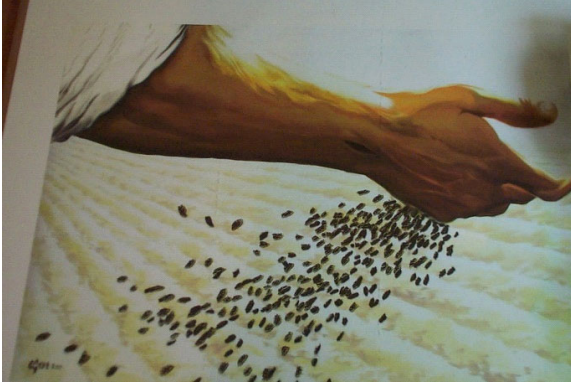
C. In the Kingdom of God what you can or can’t do is not based on your ability or the circumstances surrounding you. What you can or cannot do in the

Kingdom is based on your ability to believe. (Mark 9:23)

1. If you can believe it, then it becomes possible for you
2. David didn't have the natural ability to defeat Goliath & the circumstances surrounding him were not favorable, but he wasn't limited to his natural ability or the circumstances surrounding him, he was only limited based on what he believed
3. You are limited or empowered by what you believe
 - a. The Children of Israel were limited, Joshua and Caleb were empowered
 - b. The army of Israel was limited, David was empowered

D. **APPLICATION:** If you want to operate effectively in the Kingdom of God system and produces results in this system you are required to have faith (a tree). Whatever you want to do, be, or have in the Kingdom of God you have to have faith to do it.

1. If you don't believe it in your heart, you cannot become it, have it, or do it in life.
2. You are today what you believe you are. You have today what you believe you have. You're doing today what you believe you can do. If you want to be something greater, have something greater, and do something greater, then you have to believe greater.



HOW TO SOW THE WORD-SEED

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: As believers we have to know how to sow the

word properly so that we can reset our belief and see results in our lives –

Joshua 1:8

I. 8 keys to meditating the Word (Joshua 1:8, Psalm 1:1-3)

A. As you expose yourself to the Word of God your faith will grow, develop, & change (Romans 10:17)

1. As you see the Word, hear the Word, and say the Word you're sending the seed of the Word to the ground of heart and a new belief is being

developed

- a. Faith can't come and your belief cannot be changed if you're not seeing the Word, hearing the Word, and saying the Word
 - 1) If you want to see change in your life then you must change your belief and to change your belief you must send the word down these pathways for that to happen
- b. If you're not seeing the Word, hearing the Word, or saying the Word you cannot expect to see the word come to pass in your life

- 2. Meditation – To utter a sound, the act of thoughtful deliberation with the implication of speaking to oneself, to speak, to imagine, to talk, to speak, to study, to ponder

B. 8 Keys to meditating the Word

- 1. Separation is key in meditation
 - a. Jesus separated himself (Matthew 14:23, 26:36, Mark 6:46, Luke 6:12, 9:28)
 - 1) Matthew 6:6 – Enter your prayer closet, shut the door, turn the cell phone off and separate yourself
 - b. Separate yourself from distractions
 - 1) You want to do this with purpose, you want to do it effectively, and you want to give it your full attention
 - 2) This is the process that's going to change my life and I don't need to be distracted during this process

2. Speak the word out loud in your meditation time (Proverbs 18:21)
 - a. You need to hear yourself say it
 - 1) Meditation – To utter a sound with the implication of speaking to oneself
 - b. One of the most powerful roles that confessing the Word does is it changes your belief inside (Mt 21:21)
 - 1) If Words are seeds then saying is sowing
 - 2) We always talk about how our words can change our lives and that's so very true. However, until you words change the inside of your heart, then will not change the outside of your life
 - a) You aren't speaking to the mountain outside yet, you're speaking to the mountain inside
3. Always meditate the Word with purpose – Don't just go through the motions (Acts 11:23, James 5:17)
 - a. Acts 11:23 – Meditate the Word with purpose of heart
 - 1) Meditate – The act of thoughtful deliberation
 - 2) Ask yourself what's my purpose here? Then say, my purpose here is to develop my faith tree in this area because I believe that my life is coming out of my heart, and if I change what I believe I can change my life.
 - b. James 5:16 – Meditate the word with zeal, passion, and purpose
 - 1) Give your focus and your attention to meditating the Word

4. Apply the Word to yourself personally
 - a. Acts 10:34 – God is no respecter of persons
 - b. This is God talking to me, this is God’s promise to me, this is what God has provided for me
5. Place yourself in agreement with what the Word says about you
 - a. Make a decision of quality to agree with the word by faith (John 20:25)
 - 1) I agree with this by faith
 - b. To believe something begins as an act of your will
6. Remember your blood covenant and realize that God cannot lie (Hebrews 6:17)
 - a. God stood in blood and promised this to me; He swore by Himself where this is concerned
 - b. It’s impossible for God to lie; this must be true
7. Ponder how the Word changes your situation
 - a. Knowing that this is true how does that change my situation and my attitude?
8. See yourself as the Word says you are
 - a. Hebrews 11:1 – Faith is now, see yourself with it, see it as being already done
 - b. James 1:21-This Bible is a mirror & its reflecting back to me my present state. It’s reflecting back to me what I am today, not what I’m

going to become some day

II. Patience is a major key in working the Kingdom of God system

- A. A part from patience fruit will not be brought forth (Luke 8:13)
 - 1. Patience – Constancy, Endurance, Continuance, Perseverance, Consistency
 - a. Hebrews 6:12 – Minus the patience there's no inheriting the promise
 - b. Hebrews 10:35-36-Don't fling away your tree; you're fruit is with your tree, you're results are with your faith
 - c. John 8:32-It's required that you continue in the Word before it can make you free
 - d. James 1:2-4 – When patience has done it's work then you'll want nothing
- B. Why do people not reap?
 - 1. People don't reap because they faint (Galatians 6:9)
 - a. Faint – To weaken, relax, have one's strength relaxed, to be enfeebled through exhaustion, to grow weak, grow weary, be tired out
 - 2. People faint because their strength is small (Proverbs 24:10)
 - a. When you're strength is small you can't endure & persevere and resist (James 4:7)
 - 3. People's strength is small because they don't feed the spirit on the

Word of God

- a. When you don't feed your spirit on the word you have no joy and when you have no joy you have no strength (Jeremiah 15:11, Nehemiah 8:10)

4. People don't feed their spirit on the word of God because:

- a. They've been distracted away from the Word by the evil report
- b. Slothfulness and Laziness

C. The requirements to see the seed come to pass

1. If you don't understand the word-seed, Satan will take what's sown in your heart (Matthew 13:19)

- a. You can hear the word on prosperity or healing, but if you don't understand the word on prosperity or healing it can be stolen from you

1) EX: You have to understand that you ARE healed, you have to understand that healing is God's will for everybody, you have to understand that God wants it for you right now

2) EX: You have to understand that purpose for prosperity, u have to understand that you're redeemed from poverty, you have to understand tithing

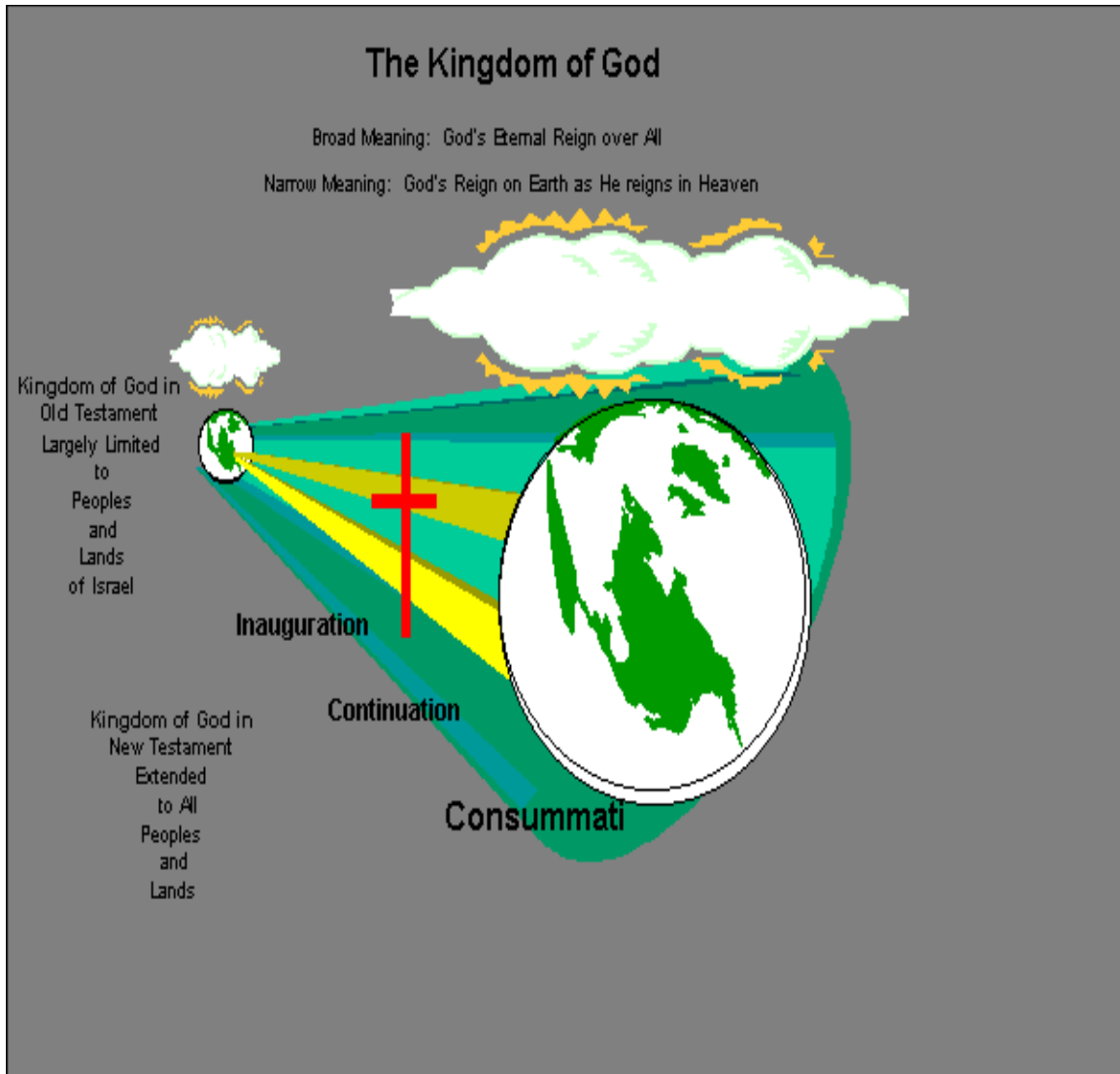
- b. When you don't understand the word, you are a candidate to have that word stolen from you

2. You have to be committed (Mark 4:16-17)

- a. Inspiration without commitment won't produce results

- b. Luke 8:12 – Fruit is brought forth with patience
 - c. James 1:2-4 – When patience has done it's work then you'll want nothing
 - d. John 8:32-It's required that you continue in the Word before it can make you free
 - e. Hebrews 6:12 – Through faith and patience you get the harvest
3. You have to give the word priority (Mark 4:19)
- a. Prov 13:13-People who continually chose things over the Word see destruction
 - b. You can't be distracted by the cares of the world
 - c. You can't desire other things more than you desire the word

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 1)



RENEWING THE MIND

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: To operate in the Kingdom of God lifestyle, which is a new way of operating in the Earth (a new way of thinking, talking, and acting) you first of all **MUST** change the way that you think to line up with this new system.

I. To operate in the Kingdom of God system, we are first of all going to have to change the way that we think (Mark 1:14-15)

- A. The “gospel of the Kingdom” is going to tell us how to talk, think, and act in way that’s going to enable us to live successfully in the Earth
 - 1. We got to stop operating on the level of the world and live out the lifestyle of the Kingdom of God
 - 2. Many times believers stop at salvation and eat milk for 40 years
- B. Everything in the Kingdom of God lifestyle is different, because it is a brand new lifestyle
 - 1. There’s a different way of talking, thinking, acting, finance, and health
- C. There is a new way of doing things and we have to change the way that we think to line up with this new system
 - 1. Our mindset hasn’t been in line with God’s (Isaiah 55:8-11)
 - 2. We have to think on the level of God
 - a. Where did I get that thought? Did that come from the word?

II. We have to unhook from the system of the world and hook into the system of the Kingdom and we do that by, first of all, changing our mindset

- A. Many believers have gotten born again and placed in the Kingdom of God, but because they haven’t changed their mindset they are still hooked to the world’s system and operating under it
 - 1. You can’t be hooked to that world’s system and get Kingdom results
 - 2. As long as you think like the world you’ll operate like the world (Romans 8:5)
- B. Jesus took us out of the world; now we need to get the world out of us (Colossians 1:12-13)
 - 1. When they moved from Egypt into the wilderness they built a calf
 - a. God didn’t teach Abraham to build a calf, Abraham didn’t teach Isaac, Isaac didn’t teach Jacob, and Jacob didn’t teach Joseph. They learned that in Egypt.
 - b. They were in the wilderness and out of Egypt when they built this calf, but Egypt wasn’t out of them.
 - c. That calf came was transferred from Egypt into the wilderness in the hearts
 - d. God took us out of the world and a lot of times believers come into the Kingdom and don’t engage in the process of getting the world out of them. So even though they’re in the Kingdom, things they learned in the world are still coming out of them.
 - e. Kingd
 - 2. The way you used to live life, you got to put that off (Eph 4:22-24)
 - a. This is written to born again people so obviously born again people can still be operating according the former way of life that they operated in before they

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 2)



WE ARE SPIRITUAL BEINGS

FOUNDATION SERIES STATEMENT: To operate in the Kingdom of God system you must operate out of your spirit and not your flesh. The Kingdom of God system is a spiritual system that runs on spiritual principles that must be applied by a spirit-being. You cannot operate from the standpoint of your flesh and operate in the Kingdom of God system.

FOUNDATION MESSAGE STATEMENT: You must understand that you are a spirit being, you're from a foreign land, and you are living in a place that you're not from

I. We are “spirit beings”, we have souls, we live in bodies

A. John 3:6 – You can't be born of a spirit and come out flesh; you can't be born of flesh and come out spirit

1. When God wanted a flesh body to operate in the Earth, God (Spirit) needed Mary (Flesh) to give birth to Jesus (Flesh)

B. John 4:24 – God is a spirit

1. 1 John 5:1 – If you believe that Jesus is the Christ, then you are born of God, who is a spirit, and that makes you a spirit-being

2. Acts 17:29 – My flesh sprung off of my natural parents, because that which is flesh is born of flesh, but my spirit sprung off of God because that which is born of spirit is spirit

C. 1 Thessalonians 5:23 – We are tri-part beings; you are spirit, you have a soul, you live in a body

1. You are spirit first

a. 1 Corinthians 9:27 – “I” is Paul the spirit

b. Romans 12:1 – “You” are not your bodies

c. Philippians 1:21-24 – “I” the spirit abides in flesh

d. 2 Corinthians 4:16 – The inward man

e. 1 Peter 3:4 – The hidden man of the heart

2. You are not natural having a spiritual experience, you are spirit having a natural experience

a. You're not natural, you're supernatural or above natural

II. We, as spirit-beings, we are not of the world (John 17:14)

A. John 8:23 – Jesus didn't originate, come from, or come out of the world, he originated, came from, and came out of God

1. John 17:14 – We are not of the world even as he his not of this world.

a. We didn't originate, come from, or come out of the world; we originated, came from, and came out of God

2. We're from another planet called Heaven

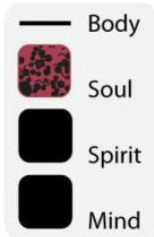
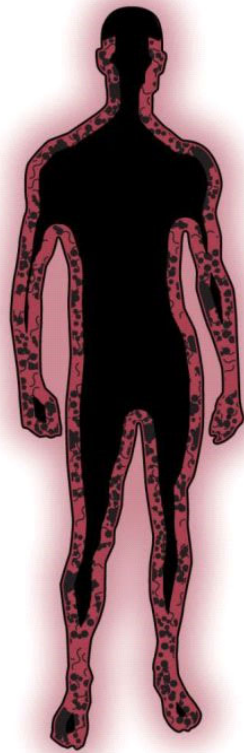
B. We are spirit-beings sent from a spiritual government and we are not of this world, we are of God/Heaven (2 Corinthians 5:20)

1. Jesus operated as a spirit being in the Earth

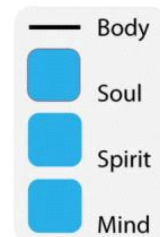
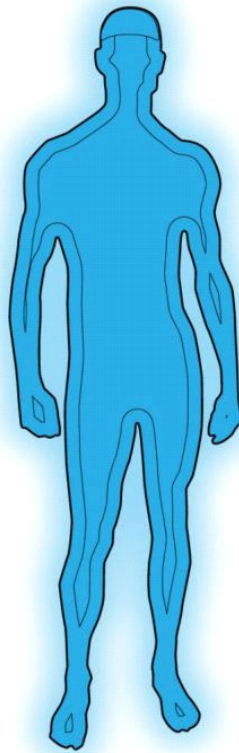
a. To properly represent our King, who is a spirit, we are going to have to think,

A DIFFERENT WAY OF OPERATING

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: To operate in the Kingdom of God system you must operate out of your spirit and not your flesh. The Kingdom of God system is a spiritual system that runs on spiritual principles that must be applied by a spirit-being. You cannot operate from the standpoint of your flesh and operate in the Kingdom of God system.

I. When we operate as spirit-beings in the Kingdom of God lifestyle it's going to look foolish to the world

A. Our system and the way we operate is totally different to the world's system and even the system of religion that the world has set up

1. 1 Corinthians 3:19 – What the world and it's system thinks is wise, God thinks is foolish and silly
 - a. EX: It's foolish to God for you to say what you have, because he told you that you could have what you say
2. The Kingdom of God system is 180 degrees in the opposite direction of the system of the world
 - a. The love system-We love all the time, they only love what's lovely
 - b. The financial system-We sow all the time, they hoard up
 - c. The healing system-We confess healing, they talk the sickness
3. 1 Corinthians 2:14 (AMP)
 - a. Natural man thinks that spiritual things are foolish and silly

B. We don't need to be **obnoxious**, but we must operate out of our spirits working the Kingdom of God system, not hiding our Heavenly citizenship

1. One thing that many believers have done is they act real spiritual in front of the world and it's a phony front to look spiritual, but it's not who they really are
 - a. We need to get to the place where operating out of our spirits in Kingdom of God lifestyle is just who we are
2. Jesus operated out of his spirit and worked the kingdom system (Mark 5:35-42, Luke 8:51-55)
 - a. Jesus shows up to the house and Jairus' family is doing what the world does in those types of situations, they are weeping and wailing
 - i. Were they weeping and wailing in faith or in fear? Fear
 - ii. Why were they weeping and wailing? Because in their system, as flesh beings, she was dead and there's no way that they can change it and the only thing left to do in that system is tumult
 - iii. Was weeping and wailing going to raise that girl from the dead? No
 - b. Jesus shows up as a spirit-being operating out of His spirit and working the kingdom of God system
 - i. They said the girl was dead, but Jesus said she was asleep, what is he doing? In the natural is she dead?
 - a) Luke 8:55 – Her spirit had left her body so she must have been dead.

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 4)





LIVING OUT OF YOUR SPIRIT

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: To operate in the Kingdom of God system you must operate out of your spirit and not your flesh. The Kingdom of God system is a spiritual system that runs on spiritual principles that must be applied by a spirit-being. You cannot operate from the standpoint of your flesh and operate in the Kingdom of God system.

I. To operate in the Kingdom of God system you are required to operate and function out of your spirit and not your flesh

A. The Kingdom of God is a spiritual reality because it's an unseen kingdom (Luke 17:20-21)

1. The Kingdom of God system is not of this world. It is a spiritual system that operates on spiritual principles (John 18:36)

B. The Kingdom of God is spiritual reality and to operate in it you must operate as a spirit-being (John 3:1-6)

1. A person who is not born again cannot enter into God's ways of doing things because they can't operate out of their spirit

a. You can't operate out of your flesh and work the spiritual system of the Kingdom of God

b. 1 Cor 15:50-Flesh and blood cannot inherit the Kingdom of God

2. A person who is not born again cannot see, know, or understand the Kingdom of God and how it operates

a. 1 Corinthians 2:14 (AMP) 79

i. A person who is not born again or even carnal Christians will not understand God's system because they still think on a carnal level

b. A lot of what you do in the Kingdom of God will not make sense to your flesh or other fleshy people

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 5)



OPERATING OUT OF YOUR SPIRIT (Part 2)

I. As long as we operate in God's system out of our spirits and not our flesh, then Satan cannot defeat us. For him to win he must pull us down to the level of our flesh and get us to operate out of our flesh.

A. In the Garden of Eden Satan pulled Eve down to the physical level and defeated her. He got her to operate as flesh instead of spirit (Genesis 3)

1. The revelation knowledge from God was that if you eat of this tree you will surely die the day that you eat of it (Genesis 2:17)

2. The information knowledge that Eve gained through her five physical senses was that the tree was good for food and it would make a person wise if they ate it (Genesis 3:6)

a. Who told her it was good for food? Who told her that it would make her wise?

i. That was information that she got through her five physical senses

3. When she came down and stopped operating on revelation out of her spirit and started operating on information out of her flesh she was defeated

B. In the wilderness Satan tried to get Jesus to come down and operate on the level of the flesh but Jesus wouldn't do it (Matt 4)

1. What he was saying to Jesus was, "Jesus if you are what God says you are, then prove it with physical evidence."

2. Jesus said, "Man doesn't live by the physical, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God."

a. Jesus is saying I don't need any thing physical to prove that I am what God says I am. I am a spirit being and I don't need anything physical to believe.

II. We must go beyond the boundary of our five physical senses, which we got locked into at the fall of man and operate in the unseen realm

A. The Kingdom of God is also the realm of god

1. We can't operate in the realm of our senses and expect to live successfully in the Earth

B. When Adam sinned he was trapped in the realm of the flesh and limited to the realm of the flesh and he could no longer operate as a spirit-being

1. His flesh was dictating to his mind what's true and his mind and body are telling his spirit what's true

a. The flesh has talked so loud that we haven't heard the spirit

2. After Adam sinned if he couldn't access it with his senses, then he couldn't get to it

a. He cannot operate in the realm of the unseen

C. Before you're born again the sense realm is the boundary for your life again and you couldn't go any further than what you can see, feel, smell, taste or hear (2 Corinthians 4:18, 5:7)

1. When you got born again you received the measure of faith and you are no

COMING OUT OF DECEPTION

What Is Deception?

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: Deception is a weapon used by Satan to keep believers under the bondage of his system(Babylonian System). As believers to come out of the bondage of Satan's system, we must come out of deception by getting the truth of God's Word.

I. Satan has a kingdom, a system, or a way of doing things that has been established in the Earth by men who work for him (Matthew 12:25)

- A. Satan's kingdom/system is designed to keep you from reaching your full potential and experiencing God's best in your life
 - 1. There are too many believers who aren't walking in their potential and experiencing God's best in their lives and the reason is because they are still hooked to the world's way of doing things
 - a. You can't reach the destinations that God has for you and do things the world's way
 - 2. Psalm 81:10:14 – God had better for them, but they didn't reach their full potential or experience God's best because they did things their way and not God's way
 - a. 10. God brought them out of Egypt (the world), but they were still doing things

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 7)



COMING OUT OF DECEPTION

Aspects Of Deception

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: Deception is a weapon used by Satan to keep believers under the bondage of his system. As believers to come out of the bondage of Satan's system, we must come out of deception by getting the truth of God's Word.

I. The two aspects of deception – If deception is going to work, these two things must be in place

- A. If deception is going to work, the deceiver has to make a lie look true
 - 1. A deceiver knows what he's saying isn't true so he tries to make it look true (Genesis 27:1-24)
 - a. A deceiver knows the truth
 - i. Jacob knew he wasn't Esau
 - 2. One way that he makes a lie look true is he'll use scriptures in the wrong way to make what's He's saying look like it's scriptural (Gen 3:1, Mt 4:3-7)
 - 3. The second way that Satan makes a lie look true his he submits physical evidence that lines up with his lie, to see if you'll judge it as true
 - a. They made Jacob to feel like Esau to Isaac
- B. If deception is going to work the deceiver has to quarantine the deceived from truth – Satan has to quarantine the Church from truth
 - 1. If a person doesn't know truth, then they are vulnerable to deception
 - a. If I don't know what the real looks like I'll never be able to spot the counterfeit
 - i. Isaac couldn't see the truth and was vulnerable to deception
 - 2. Satan wants to keep people out of the truth/word, he wants to keep preachers from preaching the word/truth, and if you are in the word and hearing it preached he wants to twist it, water it down, and compromise it
 - a. 2 Timothy 4:2-4 (AMP)
 - b. Satan doesn't want somebody in here preaching debt-deliverance, everybody gets healed, and victory all of the time because if you get the truth on that, you'll come out of deception and walk in that. He wants to keep you from those truths.

II. Believers are deceived for two reasons

- A. Believers are deceived because they don't know the truth
 - 1. These can be people who don't even know what the word says or people who think they know what the Word says, but they don't
 - a. Genesis 2:17, 3:4 – Eve's misquoting God and she was deceived because she didn't know the truth
 - b. You got to get in the book and find out what the truth is
 - 2. One reason that believers don't know the truth is because they haven't heard the truth (They might not have heard the truth because they don't come to church or they come to church and the truth is not preached)
 - a. You need to know the truth (what the Word says) because that will make you free and not knowing the truth will keep you in bondage

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 8)



COMING OUT OF DECEPTION



Revelation Knowledge

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: Deception is a weapon used by Satan to keep believers under the bondage of his system. As believers to come out of the bondage of Satan's system, we must come out of deception by getting the truth of God's Word

I. Revelation knowledge is the key component in walking free from deception

A. Revelation knowledge is when the Word of God enters your heart bringing illumination and giving you a perspective that you didn't have before the revelation came

1. Matthew 8:23-27, 16:13

a. Jesus was the Christ, the son of the living God in Matthew 8 as much as he was in Matthew 16, but in Matthew 8 Peter had no revelation

b. When the word of God entered his heart and revelation came it brought with it illumination and gave him a Godly perspective

2. Revelation gives you Godly sight and allows you to see things for how they TRULY/REALLY are

B. Without revelation you can't see truth

1. When you can't see truth you are vulnerable to deception

a. Isaac was vulnerable to deception his eyes were dim and he couldn't see truth (Genesis 27:1)

2. The entrance of God's Word brings revelation or light, enabling you to see truth (Psalm 119:30)

a. When a person doesn't have revelation spiritual sight is diminished and they can't see the truth

3. 1 Samuel 17 – People who have no revelation are spiritually blind to truth and therefore easily deceived

a. The Truth – Every man in that army was in covenant with God and Goliath wasn't and that made him very small and each one of them very big

b. The men of Israel couldn't see truth because they had no revelation

i. With no revelation, they were in the dark, and in the dark Goliath was huge

ii. If God would have taken the spiritual light of his word and shined it on that

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 9)





THINKING BIG

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: The kingdom of God demands that you think big because it was designed to accomplish the “impossible”, reach the “unreachable”, and attain the “unattainable.” In the Kingdom of God we cannot think in terms of limitations, because the Kingdom of God has no limitations.

I. The Kingdom of God has no limitations and to operate in it you can't think in terms of limitations

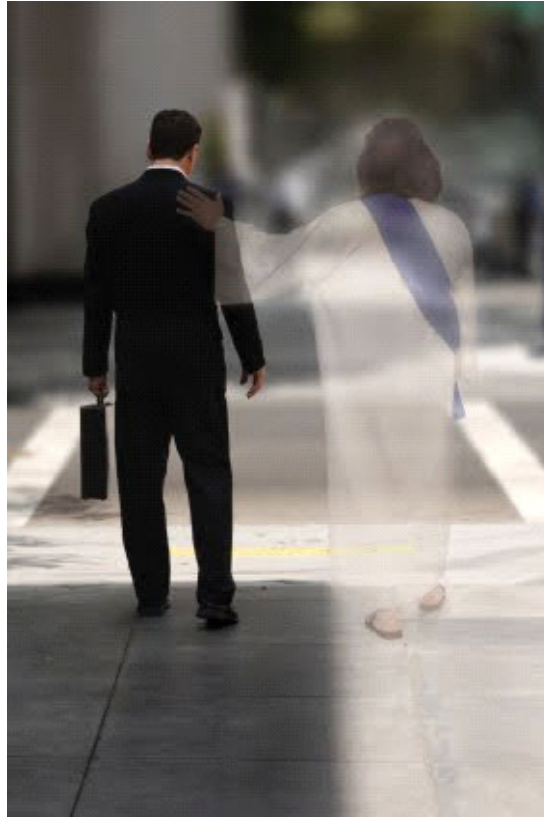
- A. The Kingdom of God rules over all (Psalm 103:19)
 - 1. There is no situation or circumstance that this system called the Kingdom of God cannot overcome
- B. The Kingdom of God is in supernatural power (1 Corinthians 4:20)
 - 1. Power (Dunamis) – power for performing miracles, ability to perform anything, works of a supernatural origin that cannot be produced by natural agents and means
 - a. The Kingdom of God system is a supernatural system designed to produce supernatural results
- C. We have to have an “all things are possible” mindset (Mark 9:23)
 - 1. It is of great necessity that if you're going to operate in the Kingdom of God you think BIG

II. You can't go any further in life, than how you think

- A. Your life is a reproduction of your thought life (Proverbs 23:7)
 - 1. What I have in life right now is direct result of how I think in my heart
 - 2. If you want to change your life then you're going to have to change the way you think
 - a. The most powerful thing that you can do for a person is change the way that they think

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 10)





GOD WITH ME

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: In the Kingdom of God you must have a God-with-me consciousness. You must act as though it is you and God and not just you.

I. One of the main deceptions of the devil is that he wants you to act as though you have to accomplish the thing in your own natural ability without God

A. Satan wants you to think from the standpoint of your natural flesh

1. Satan wants you to look at the obstacle from the standpoint that you are a limited, natural being, without God

a. In other words, it's you out there alone, without God, having to do something in your natural ability

b. He wants you to think that you have to accomplish the thing in your own wisdom, in your own power, and in your strength

2. When people look at situations from the standpoint of their flesh that keeps them from attacking the "impossible" and accomplishing things that are beyond their natural ability

a. When you think that you have to do it in your own power, you won't go after the "impossible"

B. One thing that's kept us from seeing the supernatural in our lives is we think that we got to do it

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1. When we think we have to do it in our own natural ability, we go find something that we can do

a. We need to stop looking for stuff that we can do and start looking for stuff that God can do

C. You can't do it without God. You can't do it without God. He is in the Earth

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 11)





TIMLESS TALK

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: In the Kingdom of God our language is timeless. When you talk in time you put off the promises of God to a future date. However, when you talk in faith, you put those promises on right now.

I. God does not deal in time

A. God is eternal (Deuteronomy 33:27)

1. There's no way of measuring eternity because there is no beginning and no end
 - a. If there's never a start and never an end then there is no time because time has to have a start and an end
 - i. EX: If don't ever start the stop watch then there's no time
2. God never started, He always was
 - a. How Old Is God? God has no beginning so you can't measure him in terms of time
 - b. Before time was God was; God was before the beginning (Genesis 1:1)

B. God is the I AM (Exodus 3:14)

1. God is not the I'm going to be, or I once was
 - a. 2000 years ago God never was, 2000 years ago God is
 - b. Last year you were, Last year ^{God} is, Next year you're going to be, next year God is
2. John 8:56-58
 - a. You're not yet 50 – They thought they could measure Jesus in time
 - b. He didn't say before Abraham was I was, he said before Abraham was, I am

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 12)





GOD YOUR SOURCE

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: As believers we must stop looking to world's way to get out needs met and start looking to God and His way. That is what it means to make God your source.

I. If we are going to work God's system, then we have to make God our sole source and supply

A. God is our provider

1. Matthew 6:24-34

a. 24-Mammon – An expression used by the Jewish community of NT times to express the idea of worldliness.

i. The idea here is whoever you serve is your master and he is responsible for being your source

a) If a person is a servant in a household, then the master provides everything that they need

b) If you serve the system of the world, then the system of the world is your source, if you serve God and his system, then God and his system of your source

ii. 25-Because you can't serve two masters, serve God, make Him your source, and He will provide what you need

b. Jesus is showing them God the provider and then revealing to them that they need to trust Him

i. 26,30-God provided the birds food and clothes for the grass of the field

ii. 30-Trust God as your source 95If you're worrying then you're not trusting

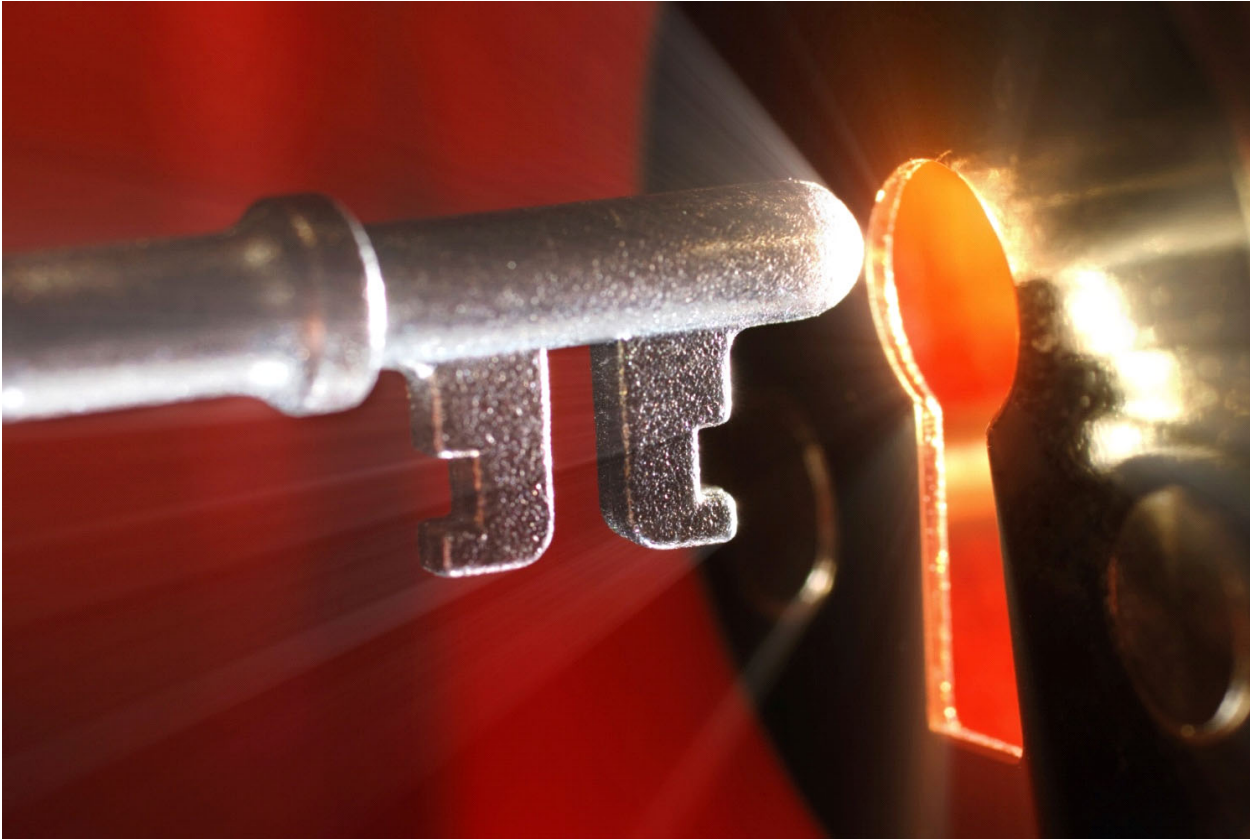
c. The world's system (that Babylonian system) can be defined as man trying to get his needs met apart from God

i. 31-Therefore – Because God is a trustworthy provider

ii. 32-Gentiles seek things, because they got to be their own source and get their needs met without God

ACTIVATING THE KINGDOM

Spiritual Law

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: The Kingdom of God system is not activated because you're in need; it's activated when you engage in the principles of it.

I. God was moved by your need and he met every need that you would ever have at the foundation of the world

- A. God is finished where obtaining and providing your victory is concerned
 - 1. Hebrews 4:3 (AMP)
 - a. Revelation 13:8 – Jesus was slain before the foundation of the world
 - b. Ephesians 1:3-4 – We were blessed with all spiritual blessing before the foundation of the world
 - c. John 17:23-24 – God started loving you before the foundation of the world
 - 2. God knows what you have need of before you ask him (Matthew 6:8)
 - a. God knew what you would need before you were ever here and he provided it
 - i. God's finished where obtaining and providing your need is concerned
- B. In this Kingdom of God system, we got to get rid of the thinking that we are waiting on God to obtain and provide
 - 1. 2 Chronicles 16:9, Isaiah 30:18 (AMP) – God is waiting on us

II. God has provided a system of laws and principles that we must get involved in to receive the provision that he has provided

- A. God, the power of God, and the system of God are not activated and moved into action because there is a need. They are activated and moved into when somebody

KINGDOM PRINCIPLES (Part 14)



ACTIVATING THE KINGDOM



The Perfect Law Of Liberty

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: The Kingdom of God system is not activated because you're in need; it's activated when you engage in the principles of it.

I. The Word of God is the perfect law of liberty (James 1:25)

A. A law is something that will produce the same results every time all the time no matter what as long as the principles of that law are applied

1. A law is something that has a predictable outcome

- a. If a person abides by certain principles there is a predetermined outcome
- b. You're not going to apply the principles of a law and get inconsistent results
- c. EXAMPLE: Gravity – you're not going to jump off of a building and float one time and fall the other

2. The only prerequisite for a law to work is that the principles must be applied

- a. The Law of Lift – Thrust over drag = lift
 - i. If thrust or drag isn't there you cannot fly
 - b. If the law doesn't work we must assume the principles aren't in place
 - i. If the principles were in place and the law didn't work it's not a law

3. The Word of God is spiritual law that has the predetermined outcome of freedom (James 1:25, John 8:32-34)

a. James 1:25, Psalm 103:19 – The Kingdom of God system rules over all and will free me in any situation

i. Perfect – faultless – You can rely on the Word; you'll never do the Word and the Word not work

a) Joshua 1:5 – I the Word will not fail you

ii. Liberty – Freedom, not bound

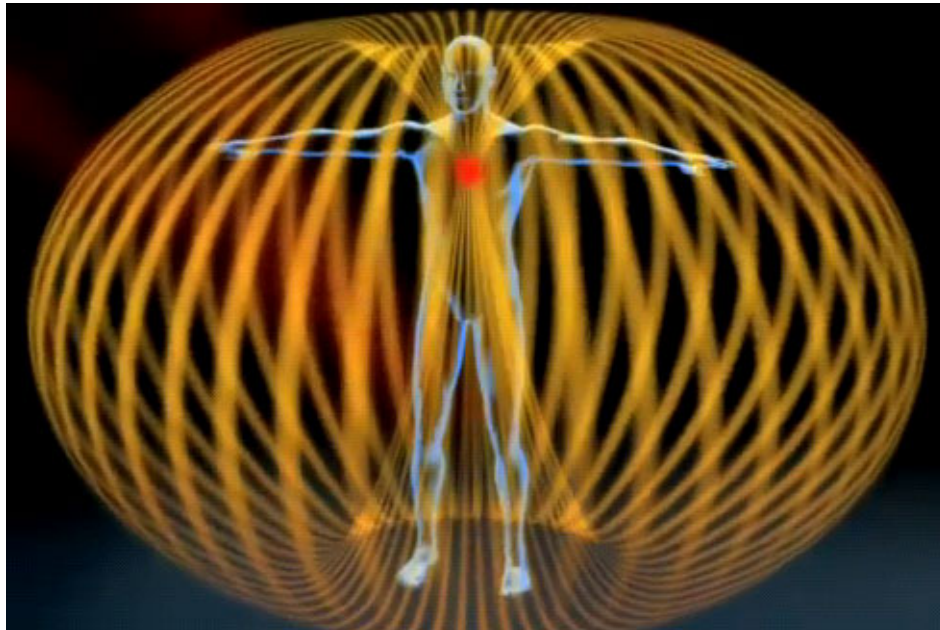
a) The word will leave you totally and completely free whatever you need to be free from

b. John 8:28-32

ACTIVATING THE KINGDOM



The Importance Of Understanding Spiritual Law

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: The Kingdom of God system is not activated because you're in need; it's activated when you engage in the principles of it.

I. We cannot to take our education in the Kingdom of God lightly if we want to become proficient in working the system of God effectively. As believers we've taken our education in the Kingdom of God lightly and because of it we've lacked knowledge about the laws and principles of this system.

A. The importance of learning the Word

1. Hosea 4:6 – Not knowing the spiritual law of God's Word can keep you from things that are rightfully yours

a. Destroyed – Cut off --- When you are cut off from something, there's something there that you can't get to

i. Can not knowing the law of salvation, cut you off from salvation? Can not knowing the law of healing cut you off from healing? Can not knowing the law of prosperity cut you off from prospering?

b. This all began because they rejected knowledge

i. They despised it and refused it and it cost them

ii. A person who has little to no hunger for the Word of God will be cut off from most of the provision that God has for them because they don't know the laws necessary to access the provision

c. Proverbs 13:13 – If the Word is not significant to you destruction will be the results

i. Destroyed – To be bound

a) If you despise learning and understanding the law of liberty you're going to

KINGDOM AMBASSADORS (1)





KINGDOM AMBASSADORS

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: As believers we are ambassadors are called to the “impossible”, sent into the Earth, and equipped with everything necessary to carry out our assignment.

I. We are ambassadors on assignment from Heaven sent into the Earth (2 Corinthians 5:20)

A. What is an Ambassador?

1. An envoy sent to represent a nation in a foreign land
2. A diplomatic agent of the highest rank endorsed by a foreign government or king
3. An authorized messenger who has the power to make decisions and to represent the will of the government, nation, or king he represents.
4. An official representative who is authorized to speak on behalf of his sender

B. We are ambassadors for Christ

1. We are not of the world (John 17:14)
 - a. John 8:23 – Jesus is from above and not of this world and that means even as he is from above and not from this world I’m from above, and I’m not of this world
 - b. We are not from the land that we are in, we’ve been sent by God as an authorized representative to represent our King in this foreign land
2. We have authority in the Earth to carry out the will of the one who sent us
 - a. John 3:31 – He that comes from above is above all
 - i. There’s a dominion mandate on the lives of believers
3. We represent Heaven and we are here to carry out the will of our King
 - a. We’re not here to carry out our will, but His will
 - b. Hebrews 13:20-21 – We are the vital part to the will of God being carried out in this Earth

KINGDOM AMBASSADORS (2)



KINGDOM ASSIGNMENT

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: As believers we are ambassadors are called to the “impossible”, sent into the Earth, and equipped with everything necessary to carry out our assignment.

I. The assignment for mankind hasn't changed since the Garden of Eden (Genesis 1:26-28)

- A. Man has been given an assignment to replenish the whole Earth
 - 1. Fruitful – Increase, grow, bring forth, bring fruit, make fruitful
 - 2. Multiply** – Be or become great, many, much, numerous, multiply (of people, animals, things), to be or grow great, to make large, enlarge, increase, to make much, make many, have many, to multiply, to make much to do, do much in respect of, to increase greatly or exceedingly, to make great, enlarge, do much, abundance
 - 3. Replenish – fill, full, fulfill, overflow, satisfy, abundance
 - Subdue – To subject, subdue, force, keep under, bring into bondage, make subservient, dominate, tread down
 - 4. Dominion - rule, dominion, take, prevail, reign, ruler
 - 5. Psalm 8:4-8 – Man was made to have dominion over the works of God's hands
- B. God formed man's body with dust of the Earth, but he created the spirit of man with his words (Genesis 2:7)
 - 1. Genesis 1:26 – The Word's that God spoke to create man and man became a speaking spirit like God
 - a. Genesis 1:28 – The first words that man ever heard
 - 2. Genesis 2:8 – God created man and put man in the Garden of Eden because His will was that man live on this Earth never knowing one day of lack
 - a. Eden – Pleasure, Luxury, Delight, Paradise,
 - 3. Here Adam stands inside the Garden of Eden with an assignment to fill the whole Earth up with that Garden that he's standing in (Genesis 2:7-8)
 - a. That Garden was a spot and it was man's job to turn the Earth into the Garden of Eden – To bless the whole Earth
- C. God's plan for the Earth and man did not change because of Adam's sin
 - 1. God's got the whole Earth on his mind
 - a. Gen 9:1,7- Noah
 - b. Gen 12:3, 18:18, 22:18-Abraham
 - c. Gen 26:4-Isaac
 - d. Gen 28:13-14-Jacob

II. Our assignment is to manifest the Garden of Eden everywhere we go

- A. Jesus was sent by the Father to bring Heaven to the Earth
 - 1. Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8)
 - a. Destroy – Undo, destroy, dissolve, untie, break, put off, melt, to loosen

KINGDOM AMBASSADORS (3)



TAKING THE EARTH BACK

FOUNDATION STATEMENT: As believers we are ambassadors are called to the “impossible”, sent into the Earth, and equipped with everything necessary to carry out our assignment.

I. You are an ambassador and a citizen of Heaven. You are appointed by the King. You are not voted in, but appointed in. You are representing another government, a foreign power called the Kingdom of God. Heaven is your original country and you’ve come to dominate this territory and make this Earth like Heaven. You must complete your assignment and you must not die until it is all done.

A. This is not the devil's Earth; This is our Earth

1. Isaiah 14:16-17

a. Satan's out to make the world and wilderness

i. Wilderness – wasteland, barren, desolate, land that supports little life

b. He wants to weaken nations

i. Weaken – overcome, defeat, waste way

c. He wants to destroy cities

i. Destroy – Overthrow; he wants to be in charge

d. We've been sent to not allow him to be in charge in the Earth

2. Psalm 37:9

a. Inherit (yaras) – To have as a possession or to take possession of, carries the idea of gaining by right or violence

3. Psalm 37:11

a. The meek – The humble

i. 1 Peter 5:6 – The truly humble are the ones who put themselves under the authority of the Word of God

b. Peace (Shalom) – peace, safety, prosperity, well-being, wholeness,

4. Psalm 37:19-22

a. Those who have received the blessing shall inherit the Earth

5. The Earth has been given to man

a. An inheritance is something that you receive when somebody else dies and then wills it to you

b. Psalm 115:16 – God has given the Earth to the children of men

c. Psalm 24:1 – This Earth is mine so it's His and it's His so it's mine and through me and you He wants to turn this Earth back into the Garden of Eden

6. One of the main reasons Satan came after Job is because he was rich and running everything (Job 1:4) 107

B. God's got that Garden on His mind

1. Ezekiel 36:33-36

a. The desolate lands are about to become the Garden of the Lord

i. Desolate – deserted, ravaged, devastated, ruined
