101 SIMPLE COMPARISONS BETWEEN LAW + GRACE Even though as believers we are not under law but under grace, we still have the effects of our old life under the law imprinted in our minds - that is a law mindset. A law mindset is an old way of thinking that causes you to rely on your performance to make things happen. Instead of relying on the indwelling life of Christ:

- You strive to become what you already are
- You seek to find what you already possess
- You try to measure up you when you already do
- You try to cross a divide that isn't there
- You ask God to do what He's already done

In short, you try to re-accomplish what Christ already has accomplished on your behalf. A law mindset causes you to sin, make you feel condemned and gives you a sense you're never doing enough. Talking about frustration!

The moment you choose to believe the Gospel of Grace, however, you'll experience rest, joy and freedom because you stop trying and start trusting. To experience restful trust and live in joyful freedom we need to be able to discern law from grace.

Here's a Cheat Sheet with 101 simple comparisons between a law mindset versus a grace mindset.

I trust this Cheat Sheet helps you to discern law from grace in order to live in joyful freedom. However, I know how hard it can be to spot law preaching, especially if you're new to the message of grace. For that reason here's a simple question that will help you know if you are being deceived by law preaching or if you are enjoying undiluted grace preaching: does this preaching or practice point to Christ and His performance or to you and your performance?

- \rightarrow If it points to Christ, what He has done and who you are in Him = Grace
- \rightarrow If it points to you, what you have done or what you must do = Law

In other words, grace makes you Christ-conscious and law makes you self-conscious.
