- 2. How does Paul describe Luke in Colossians 4:14 in the NIV Bible?
- 3. Some people will be surprised to learn Timothy's name also appears in the book of Hebrews. In Hebrews 13:23, what does it say happened to him?
- 4. "And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will demons;..." (Mark 16:17). Which of these completes Jesus' teaching about what those who believed in him would do concerning demons?
- 5. What's the common link between Lydia and the Jailer?
- 6. What's the common link between Bartholomew and Thomas?
- 7. According to 1 John 4:10 (New International Version), how can believers know God loves them?
- 8. According to Galatians 3: 13 and 14, in the King James Version of the Bible, how did Christ redeem all those who believe on Him, extending God's blessings to the Gentiles as well as to the Jews?

- 9. Titus: "Encourage the young men to be _____." What fills the gap in the New International Version?
- 10. After the crucifixion, the disciples were in despair. All day Easter Sunday, only Mary Magdalene saw or spoke with the resurrected Jesus. However, John writes that, later, Jesus dramatically revealed Himself to the disciples three times. Those three times are listed here. Which of the following is NOT one of John's three? (All happened. You are looking for the one that happened before the resurrection.)
- 11. In which book would you find these words? "To those who have been called, who are loved by God the Father and kept by Jesus Christ."
- 12. Freedom (liberty) is an important Bible teaching. Paul taught the Galatian Christians that they were to stand in the liberty through which Christ had made them free (Galatians 5:1). What is the apparent temptation that followed this newfound liberty and freedom found in Galatians 5:13?
- 13. The writer of this book still causes controversy as to authorship to this day -- but which book is it? "Do not harm the land or the sea or the trees until we put a seal on the foreheads of the servants of our God."
- 14. While Mary was pregnant with Jesus, her cousin, Elizabeth, was also with child. What would Elizabeth's child come to be named?
- 15. What day of the week did Jesus rise?
- 16. "The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The Scripture does not say 'and to seeds,' meaning many people, but 'and to your seed,' meaning one person, who is Christ."

- 17. Sometimes the English word used to translate a Greek word has a different shade of meaning or emphasis than the Greek word. Hebrews 11:1 says, "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." "Hoped" is a translation of the Greek word "elpizo". What other word is sometimes used to translate the Greek word "elpizo" in the NASB?

- 26. When Jesus was performing miracles, what Old Testament prophet did He claim to be fulfilling, as per Matthew 8:17?

- 28. In the 20th chapter of the Gospel of John, whom did Mary Magdalene initially think she was addressing after her encounter with two angels that sat in the empty tomb of Jesus? (This Person later revealed to her that He was indeed the risen Christ.)
- 29. In the 24th chapter of Luke, the resurrected Jesus appeared to two men as they were on a journey from a place called Emmaus. Jesus drew near and walked with them, not revealing who He was. As the men journeyed, Jesus began to expound the scriptures to them, from Moses and all the prophets things concerning Him. One of the men was named what?
- 30. The walls of Jericho fell down after the children of Israel marched around them seven days. Which New Testament books tells us that this happened as a result of faith?
- 31. There are many words or phrases, which can describe love. Which of these is NOT one of them listed in I Corinthians 13?

- 33. The first letter to the Corinthians begins with Paul expressing concern about what problem?
